### **BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY'S 2023/24 - 2025/26 BUDGET HAS BEEN APPROVED BY COUNCIL**

"This is a budget for our communities".

So said Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, during the delivery of his budget speech on Tuesday, 30 May 2023 at a Council Meeting held at the N. Otto Community Hall in Porterville. This was the first time Bergrivier Municipality took its Council Meeting to the public in a community hall.

Bergrivier Municipality's budget for the 2023-2024 financial year, totalling at R630 million, was approved by Council on 30 May 2023.

Van Rooy mentioned that preparing the final budget was a daunting task under the current economic circumstances, both locally and globally. "Our ability to deliver good quality services to our citizens are severely being hampered by Eskom's implementation of prolonged loadshedding throughout the country. The energy crisis has a direct impact on the economic growth and revenue of the Municipality", said Van Rooy.

Despite these challenges, the delivery of excellent services and improving the quality of life of all residents remains the number one priority for Bergrivier Municipality. The budget was drafted and aligned to needs of the communities we serve, as captured in the approved Integrated Development Plan (2022-2026).

The approved budget consists of the following:

- Capital Budget of R102,441 million; and
- Operating Budget of R527,674 million.

In order to balance the budget under these challenging economic circumstances we are facing, increasing the tariff charges were unavoidable, but it was done responsibly after much deliberation.

Tariff increases which will take effect as from 1 July 2023:

- Water increases by 7%;
- Electricity increases by 15,1% (Subject to NERSA's approval);
- Refuse removal increases by 20%;
- Sewerage increases by 7%; and
- Property Rates **decreases** by 21% (due to the implementation of the new General Valuation Roll)

"In preparing the final budget, we also had to incorporate the guidelines provided by National Treasury. I can confirm Bergvliet Municipality's commitment to spend economically rather than spending the economy. It will be expected of the entire administration to continue to find alternative and innovative measures of ensuring service delivery without necessarily having to increase the cost to the taxpayer and consumer", Van Rooy boldly explained.

The Municipality will continue to support the vulnerable within the communities through the implementation of indigent subsidies to qualifying households, which will receive a support package consisting of 50 free electricity units, 6 kilolitres of free water and a 100% subsidised standard household refuse removal and sewerage tariff per month.



# VELDDRIF WINS BERGRIVIER RUGBY CUP 2023

“Congratulations to all the teams that won their respective divisions, well played. It just shows that if you keep working hard, it ultimately and eventually pays off”. These were the words of Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, who mentioned that the Rhino Park Stadium in Piketberg was packed to capacity during the Bergrivier Rugby Cup 2023 which took place on 8 April 2023.

Approximately 2 000 spectators flocked to the stadium to watch and support their favourite local rugby club. All the teams within the Bergrivier Municipal Area competed against each other (in their divisions) for top honours, a rare opportunity which they seldomly get, since many of these teams play in different regional leagues.

A total of 12 teams from across Bergrivier Municipality, namely Porterville; Piketberg; Wittewater; Velddrif; Goedverwacht; Redelinghuys; Piket-Bo-Berg; Eendekuil; Aurora and Moutonshoek, participated in the competition.

The tournament consisted of three divisions namely Division A (Mayor’s Cup); Division B (Chairman Cup); and Division C (Community Cup). The winner of Division A for the second time in a row was once again Velddrif Rugby Club, whilst Zebras from Piket-Bo-Berg won Division B for a second consecutive year and Aurora Rugby Club were the winners of Division C.

The best players on the day were as follows:

- Best forwards of the tournament – O. Musabaika (Mountain Eagles – Division C), C. Diedrich (Red Stars – Division B) and K. Adams (Piketberg Rugby Club – Division A);

- Best backline players: P. Springfield (Black Tigers – Division C), E. van der Byl (Zebras – Division B) and F. Afrika (Velddrif Rugby Club – Division A); and

- Overall best player of the tournament was B. Mbalula (Zebras – Division B).

Van Rooy explained that sports development is one of the Municipality’s top priorities and therefore invests resources into creating a platform for the sportsmen and women to showcase their talents and participate in an active lifestyle. “We can really be proud of the level of local rugby on offer in our backyard. It is my dream that we can see some of our local stars go professional and maybe one day see them on television,” said Van Rooy.

Van Rooy mentioned that the players’ humility and kindness towards him never ceases to amaze him. He is encouraged with the level of support for local rugby. “Sports can be the stepping stone to success, however, you have to be truly invested and dedicated. It also brings together different cultures and fosters life-long friendships. Support your local rugby players and clubs and let’s continue to encourage our youth to lead healthy and active lifestyles,” he said.

Van Rooy concluded: “We would like to take this opportunity to share our appreciation to the Bergrivier Sport and Recreation Association for their continuous support and partnership. Our deepest gratitude to the staff working at SAPS, our colleagues at Bergrivier Municipality, the sponsors, the volunteers, the participating rugby teams and, most importantly, thank you to all the fans both at the tournament and who watched online”.

## **BERGRIVIER GROET ROSSOUW NA 38 JAAR SE DIENS**

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het op 25 April 2023 tydens 'n Raadsvergadering die geleentheid geneem om amptelik totsiens te sê aan Neels "Sous" Rossouw, wat 'n leeftyd in diens van sy gemeenskappe deurgebring het.

Een van Rossouw (65) sê laaste uitdagings voordat hy afgetree het, het in Julie 2022 gekom nadat Eskom langdurige vlak 6 beurtkrag geïmplementeer het, en opnuut in Januarie 2023. Rossouw en sy span het gesukkel om die twee reservoires in Piketberg tot aanvaarbare vlakke vol te maak. Die Munisipaliteit kon nie inwoners van voldoende drinkbare water voorsien nie, omdat dit nie 'n minimum pomptyd van 19 uur per dag kon handhaaf nie.

Op hierdie stadium het Piketberg se Watersuiwerswerke en *Boosterstasie* geen ondersteunende kragopwekkers gehad nie en het baie ander munisipaliteite dit baie moeilik gevind om kragopwekkers aan te koop. In Januarie 2023, was kragopwekkers nie maklike items om in Suid-Afrika aan te skaf nie (veral die 880kWh wat benodig is).

Rossouw het hard gewerk om seker te maak dat die Munisipaliteit twee groot kragopwekkers kon kry, om die water krisis in Piketberg op te los. Intussen het die Munisipaliteit watertenkwaens by verskeie punte binne Piketberg ontplooи vir inwoners om drinkbare water (gratis) vir huishoudelike gebruik te verkry.

Teen die einde van Februarie (2023) het die twee reuse kragopwekkers in Piketberg aangekom en is dit geïmplementeer.

"Dit is die tipe persoon wie hy (Sous) is. Hy gee nooit op nie en het altyd 'n plan B as dinge nie uitwerk nie. Rossouw het altyd sy gemeenskappe 'n prioriteit gemaak en het baie keer laat nagte by die elektriese stasie of by enige ander incident waar krag betrokke was, deurgebring om herstelwerk te doen. Dit kos passie, deursettingsvermoë en 'n diep begeerte om met trots te wil dien," het Raadsheer Ray van Rooy, gesê.

Van Rooy het bygevoeg dat Rossouw is 'n fantastiese voorbeeld van 'n werknemer wat regtig Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se kernwaardes uitgeleef het.

Advokaat Hanlie Linde, Munisipale Bestuurder by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, het genoem dat Rossouw 'n ongelooflike begrip het van hoe elektrisiteit en die netwerke funksioneer en kon altyd deeglike tegniese raad of terugvoering deurgee na 'n elektriese fout ontstaan het. "Ons is almal hartseer om so 'n wyse mens te verloor, maar ons wens hom alle sterkte toe met sy aftrede," het Linde afgesluit.

# METERLESER HANG SY HANDSKOENE OP NA MEER AS 37 JAAR DIENS

Na meer as 37 jaar se diens het Christoffel Ockhuis (65) , 'n bekende meterleser by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit (Porterville kantoor), afgetree.

Ockhuis het sy loopbaan by die Munisipaliteit begin as 'n algemene munisipale werker by die destydse Porterville Munisipaliteit. Dit is voordat die munisipaliteite gecombineer het.

"Oom Christie" soos hy alom bekend is, het sy werk met absolute passie uitgevoer en het altyd 'n glimlag op sy gesig rondgedra. Die ervare kennis het hom instaat gestel om homself goed van sy taak te kwyt.

Advokaat Hanlie Linde, Munisipale Bestuurder by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, het gesê dat hy (Ockhuis) een van die mees lojale, betroubare en hardwerkende werkers was ten spyte van sommige moeilike weersomstandighede. Dit is vir Linde moeilik om so 'n ervare en kennisvolle mens te verloor, maar sy respekteer wel sy wense en bid hom net voorspoed toe vir die toekoms.

"Eerlikheid, lojaliteit en respek teenoor jou werk en medemens is van kardinale belang. Ek het dit aangeneem as my lewensfilosofie en dit dien as trapklippe vir 'n lang en

suksesvolle loopbaan. Verwyder alle negatiewe gedagtes en persone deur God se leiding en goeie guns," het Ockhuis afgesluit.

"Dit is die eienskappe van 'n trotse Bergrivier Munisipaliteit werknemer, wat bygedra het om vooruitstrewendheid in ons gemeenskappe te bevorder," het Raadsheer Ray van Rooy gesê.

## ESKOM BEURTKRAG KWESSIE

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se elektriese netwerke is tans onder geweldige druk wanneer toevoer na die dorpe aangeskakel word na Eskom beurtkrag.

Onder normale toestande is die elektriese aanvraag laer en meer stabiel. Tydens die Eskom beurtkrag koel warmwater silinders af en koelkaste se interne temperatuur verhoog. Sodra toevoer herstel word, skakel al die elektriese toestelle gelyk aan, wat veroorsaak dat die aanvraag vir elektrisiteit die beskikbare netwerk-kapasiteit oorskry. In sommige gevalle is die aanvraag dan dubbel die beskikbare kapasiteit.

Velddrif ondervind tans die grootste aanvraag na afloop van Eskom beurtkrag wat veroorsaak dat dele van die dorp vir langer tye af is. Soms word die Eskom netwerk-kapasiteit oorskry wat veroorsaak dat die Eskom skakelaar "trip" en die hele dorp dan weer sonder toevoer is. Onderbrekings in toevoer word deur tegnici herstel en neem dus tyd om te voltooi.

Die Monte Bertha voerder in Porterville se kapasiteit word ook oorskry, wat veroorsaak dat dele van hierdie area vir langer tye sonder elektrisiteitstoever is.

Piketberg se hoof toevoer "trip" ook tans in die Eskom substasie as gevolg van die oorlading van die netwerk.

Hiermee doen Bergrivier Munisipaliteit 'n ernstige beroep op inwoners om die volgende praktiese stappe te volg om die aanvraag vir elektrisiteit te verminder direk na Eskom beurtkrag.

- Skakel asseblief warmwatersilinders af tydens Eskom beurtkrag en eers 30 minute nadat die toevoer herstel is, weer aan;
- Wag 15 tot 30 minute voordat apparate soos stowe, verwarmers of lugversorgers aangeskakel word; en
- Stel alle batterystelsels (bv. ononderbroke kragbronne en sonkragstelsels met batterye) se omsetters om die batterye eers na 30 minute te begin herlaai.

Samewerking in hierdie verband sal tot voordeel van alle inwoners wees en die impak van Eskom beurtkrag help verlig.
