LEIERS VERGADER IN VELDDRIF OM DORPSKWESSIES TE BESPREEK

"Failing to prepare, is preparing to fail". Dit was die woorde van een bekommerde inwoner by die "Kom Red Jou Dorp-vergadering" in Velddrif.

Hoë impak leiers van die breë Velddrif area (verskeie sektore) het op Vrydag, 25 November 2022, 'n noodvergadering gehou om die toekoms van die mooi mondingsdorp te bespreek en om goeie gemeenskapsprojekte te beplan.

Daar was ongeveer 60 leiers van die gemeenskap wat elkeen hul positiewe bydrae gelewer het, om verdere morele verval, vandalisme, misdaad en die verskeie sosiale euwels te probeer bekamp.

Dr Braam Hanekom van die **Sentrum vir Publieke Getuienis in die Wes-Kaap** is genooi om die vergadering te fasiliteer. 'n Paar belangrike onderwerpe wat bespreek is sluit in vandalisme, armoede, werkloosheid, diefstal van munisipale eiendom, alkohol- en dwelmmisbruik, morele waardes en die gedrag van kinders in die gemeenskappe.

Dié gesprek het tot goeie aksieplanne geleid soos 'n "Adopt a Child Programme", jeug- en sportsontwikkelingsprogramme en die stigting van straatkomitees om misdaad hok te slaan. Elke lid van die vergadering het 'n verwantwoordelikheid om toe te sien dat hierdie planne geïmplementeer word.

"Voortgesette positiewe vennootskappe vir 'n menswaardige toekoms is uiters belangrik om 'n gesonde en voorspoedige gemeenskap te handhaaf. Ons moet voortbou op die vennootskap tussen die gemeenskap, die Munisipale Raad en die administrasie sodat ons gemeenskappe kan floreer," het Adv. Hanlie Linde, gesê.

BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY RATED 2ND BEST IN SOUTH AFRICA, ACCORDING TO INDEPENDENT GOOD GOVERNANCE AFRICA

Bergrivier Municipality has recently been rated by Good Governance Africa (GGA) as the 2nd best Municipality in South Africa, based on evidence from 2021.

A total of 205 municipalities formed part of the Good Performance Index (GPI). Local municipalities were measured and rated based on their performance in three governance categories namely: Administration, Service Delivery, and Planning and Monitoring.

"We are extremely proud of this incredible achievement. It's a true honour for us to be rated 2nd best in the country and I cannot thank our Council, administration and the public enough for their contributions towards creating a prosperous Bergrivier Municipality. Service delivery is our passion and all decisions we take are for the benefit of our communities," said Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality.

Good Governance Africa is an independent company conducting research on various organisations from across the globe via studies, and using data collection methods and analytics to then issue fair and accurate performance ratings.

It is undoubtedly clear that the Western Cape is at the forefront of local government in South Africa with 13 of the province's municipalities in the top 20.

Bergrivier Municipality has featured in the Top 10 Best Municipalities list for the last nine (9) years. In 2016, we were ranked as the 3rd best municipality in South Africa.

"We are constantly striving towards creating a prosperous community where all want to live, work, learn and play in a dignified manner. Receiving recognition from an independent institution is testament to the fact that we are on the right path to prosperity, and that excellent service delivery forms the basis for all our successes for which we are very proud of. 

PIETIE FREDERICKS YOUTH CENTRE PHASE 1 IN PIKETBERG NOW OPEN

"The future of Bergvrijer is in our children's hands".

These were the words of Executive Mayor Alderman Ray van Rooy, who as the keynote speaker at the official handover ceremony of the Pietie Fredericks Youth Centre Phase 1 in Piketberg, mentioned that youth development is a key component to the Municipality's vision of "creating a prosperous community where all want to live, work, learn and play in a dignified manner".

The ceremony took place on Monday, 31 October 2022, whereby PPC De Hoek handed over the keys of the youth centre to Bergvrijer Municipality. This project, which forms part of PPC's Social and Labour plan, is part of a process of giving back to the worthy cause of youth development.

During the negotiation phase for the possible construction of the youth centre, in partnership with the Municipality, a key factor to closing the deal was that both parties understood that a drastic change was needed to curb the high levels of social ills (e.g. unemployment, lack of skills, substance abuse) which has engulfed Piketberg. This is an issue that both Bergvrijer Municipality and PPC De Hoek was aware of.

Van Rooy placed emphasis on the importance of investing in the youth. "I strongly believe that this facility will create a solid foundation for young people to learn, grow and develop into

highly motivated, responsible, capable and employable citizens and leaders of tomorrow. The late Pietie Fredericks, whom this centre is named after, fought for youth development and this facility is in honour of his legacy. I want to thank PPC for their continued meaningful contributions within the Bergvrijer Municipal Area, and all other stakeholders that are helping to make a huge difference in young peoples lives," he said.

Van Rooy concluded by encouraging the youth to take advantage of the offerings that will stem from the activities at the Pietie Fredericks Youth Centre and urged all residents to take ownership of this prized community asset.

So says Adv. Hanlie Linde, Municipal Manager of Bergrivier Municipality, who recently (16 August 2022) signed a new five-year contract, keeping her at the helm of the organisation until 2027. Linde, who has built up 25 years of experience and knowledge in local government and law in South Africa, has now entered her third term of office as Municipal Manager.

As a Municipal Manager, Linde is the Head of Administration and the Accounting Officer of Bergivier Municipality. 
Municipal Notice: Indigent subsidies

PLAASLIKE ENTREPRENEURS WORD BEMAGTIG BY VOORSIENINGSKANAALBESTUUR WERKSWINKELS

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se Voorsieningskanaalbestuur (VKB) Departement het op 27 Oktober, 16 November asook 30 November 2022 werkswinkels in onderskeidelik Porterville, Velddrif en Piketberg aangebied om opkomende mikro-ondernehemings te bemagtig om besigheid met die munisipaliteit te doen.

Meer as 50 plaaslike entrepreneurs het die werkswinkels bygewoon.

Dit is na aanleiding van die stigting van die SMME forums in die Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se Department van Strategiese Dienste. SMME forums is reeds gestig in Piketberg, Porterville, Redelinghuys en Velddrif en die doel hiervoor is om die klein besighede te bemagtig en te verseker dat die ekonomiese van die Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied groei deurdat klein besighede gelyke toegang het tot geleenthede.

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het vir hierdie doeleindes n ooreenkoms met die West Coast Business Development Centre om te fokus op die bemagtiging van klein besighede in Bergrivier en te verseker dat hulle voldoen aan alle wetlike vereistes.

Israel Saunders, Hoof: Bates en Voorsieningskanaalbestuur, sê die plaaslike entrepreneurs wat toegang het tot sosiale media kan oor elke sewe dae op die munisipaliteit se webwerf gaan kyk vir tenders en inligting wat hulle benodig om 'n sukses van hul besigheid te maak. "Ons wil plaaslike besighede help om nie net besigheid te doen met die munisipaliteit nie, maar ook om 'n beter begrip te hê van die volledige voorsieningskanaalbestuur proses," het Saunders gesê.

"Ons wil graag hê dat meer plaaslike besighede regstreer op die Sentrale verskaffer Database (SVD) wat bedryf word deur Nasionale Tesourie. Dit is uiters belangrik, aangesien dit die eerste stap is om besigheid te doen met die munisipaliteit". Saunders voeg by dat hy baie beïndruk is met die opkoms vanjaar by die werkswinkels.

- Praktiese demonstrasies was gedoen om klein besighede te bemagtig hoe om Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se webwerf te gebruik t.o.v tenders/kwotasies en uitnodigings geplaas;
- Hoe om besigheidsinformasie t.o.v SVD van Nasionale Tesourie op te dateer;
- Handige wenke hoe om besigheidsgroei te stimuleer en aanbiedinge in te handig; en
- VKB afdeling het ook 'n oop deur beleid waar leveransies sodanige amptenare kan kom sien om hulle behulpsaam te wees met verskeie aspekte van die siklus.

Die PPPFA laat ook munisipaliteite toe om punte toe te ken vir plaaslike SMME's en besighede om die plaaslike ekonomiese groei te bevorder. Dit sal vanaf 23 Januarie 2023 in werking tree.

BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY WELCOMES NEWLY APPOINTED CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER

Communication and partnerships are essential ingredients for building sustainability.

These were the words of the newly appointed Chief Financial Officer of Bergvrievier Municipality, Davy Louw, who assumed office as of 01 September 2022.

Louw mentioned that his ultimate goal is to place Bergvrievier Municipality in a better financial position than before, through building positive partnerships, making sound financial decisions, and working towards achieving the strategic goals of the organisation.

Louw (52) was born in McGregor in 1970. He matriculated in 1988 at De Kruine Secondary School in Touwsrivier.

He obtained several qualifications which includes the following: B.Com (Accounting) – 1992 (UWC), Post Graduate Diploma in Accounting Sciences - 2008 (UNISA) and Hons B.Compt – 2009 (UNISA). Louw has been working in Local Government since August 1995, when he was employed as an accountant in the revenue section at the Touwsrivier Transitional Local Council.

Financial services in any business is very important to ensure that the entity implements and maintains sound financial policies and procedures. "It is, however, my responsibility to ensure that the Municipality remains financially viable and sustainable for the foreseeable future," said Louw. He further explains that he will, to the best of his abilities, work towards achieving the goals set out by the Financial Services Department. "Sustainable and equitable service delivery is, after all, dependent on sound financial decisions and management," said Louw.

Some of the highlights of his career include the successful implementation of mSCOA (municipal Standard Chart of Accounts) and improving the Municipal Financial Stability Score of his previous employer, Theewaterskloof Municipality, from a low rating of 30/100 to a massive high of 66/100 as at the end of June.

During this period of significant improvement in the financial status of Theewaterskloof Municipality, they also achieved consecutive clean audits from 2012/13 all the way to the 2017/18. He also ensured that they achieved a clean audit status in his final financial year as CFO (2020/21).

According to Louw, one should judge a book by its cover since "first impressions last".

When he entered Piketberg for the first time, he was extremely impressed after noticing how clean the town is, and upon further investigation, he realised that the municipal infrastructure and public amenities are of a very high standard.

Outside of his professional life, Louw is a very active and energetic person, some of his hobbies include road running, cycling and reading.

Bergvrievier Municipality wishes him well in his new position as Chief Financial Officer and may he serve all our communities with pride.



WASTE MANAGEMENT APP FOR BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY

Bergrivier Municipality has formed part of the South African Local Government Association's (Salga) pilot programme, testing the development of its Waste Management App (Application).

The Waste Management App, which can be downloaded via the Play Store on virtually any Andriod or iOS mobile device, was specifically designed to make it easy and convenient for residents to report any waste issues within the community to the local municipality, such as illegal dumping or even a pothole that needs to be fixed.

The App allows for users to report issues in real-time and receive feedback on matters of concern. The App also allows for photos to be taken of the incident being reported, and details surrounding the issue (e.g. street name) can be added before sending the report to the municipality for further investigation.

This app is currently being tested in-house, before it is made public.

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit in vennootskap met Heist-op-den-Berg het 'n komposveldtog in die Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied van stapel gestuur. Hierdie veldtog het in September 2022 in Porterville begin.

Talle inwoners in Wyk 2 het 'n geleentheid gekry om deel te wees van hierdie afvalbestuursoefening deur 'n komposhouer in ontvangs te neem en daartoe te verbind om hul afvaluitset te verminder, deur sekere huishoudelike afvalprodukte eerder te herwin of kompos daarvan te maak.

What is whistle-blowing?

- When a person provides accurate and reliable information concerning wrongdoing to a relevant authority.

Why should I blow the whistle?

- It is the responsibility of every citizen to report any form of maladministration and misuse of public funds to law-enforcement agencies.
- It is your responsibility as an active citizen to ensure that public officials remain accountable for the public funds they are entrusted with.

Your rights as a whistle-blower:

- Your identity must be protected and kept secret.
- Your personal telephone number should not be traced.
- No one should force you to reveal your identity.
- The information you provide should remain confidential.
- You should be updated on the investigation of the fraud and corruption.
