Premier hits the streets of Piketberg: The Premier of the Western Cape, Alan Winde, visited Piketberg in November 2024 to conduct general inspections at key service points such as Radie Kotzé Hospital and Piketberg Police Station, to assess the level of service delivery in town.

PREMIER MEETS WITH BUSINESS AND AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

"The plan is to be totally resilient in the Western Cape".

These were the words of Western Cape Premier, Alan Winde, during a public meeting with Piketberg residents, among them business owners and farmers on Monday 11, November 2024.

Premier Winde stressed that one of the Western Cape Government's goals is to build up the province's energy security and resilience. He noted that the province is making encouraging headway and is on track to become a net exporter of electricity by 2032 - a milestone that underscores its commitment to energy resilience.

While energy and water security are among the Premier's key priorities, he also emphasised the critical need to strengthen education and healthcare, despite budgetary constraints.

Winde also shared encouraging news about the Western Cape's unemployment rate, which has dipped to below 20% and remains the lowest in the country. However, he acknowledged that this figure remains unacceptably high, and his government must work even harder to further stimulate economic growth to create more jobs.

The following day, Tuesday, Winde returned to Piketberg for inspections at key service points, including Radie Kotzé Hospital, Piketberg Police Station, and the E-Centre located inside the Pietie Fredericks Youth Centre.

Accompanied by Bergrivier Municipality's Executive Mayor, Alderman Ray van Rooy, the Premier assessed the delivery of essential services in the community. He engaged with residents to gain firsthand insights into their experiences with healthcare, safety and digital services.

RECYCLING CAN REDUCE WASTE IN BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY BY NEARLY 70%

"Only 9% of the Municipality's waste is being recycled".

So says Jamie-Lee van Zyl, Waste Officer at Bergrivier Municipality. She added that a key aspect in reducing the amount of waste going to the regional landfill sites, is reducing the amount of recyclables and food waste contained in black bags.

Most of Bergrivier Municipality's waste is transported to Vredenburg and Highlands landfill sites, at a massive financial cost. This in turn has a direct effect on refuse removal and transfer station offloading tariffs for both residents and businesses.


"The Municipality's landfill sites are in the process of being decommissioned. In other words, it means that these facilities now only accepts builders' rubble and garden waste. All other refuse must be transported to the regional landfill sites," said Van Zyl.

The three bags system used by the Municipality as a waste management strategy allows for the separation of waste at source. This means that provision has been made for the separation of recyclables, by making use of the transparent bags provided weekly by the Municipality.

Furthermore, home composting allows for the re-use of food waste such as fruit and vegetable peels, egg shells, tea bags and coffee grounds. Garden waste such as dried grass, leaves, twigs and sticks can also be added to a compost mix.

An excerpt from the Integrated Waste Management Plan (IWMP 2019) clearly indicates that recyclables (plastic, glass, metal, paper and cardboard) and organic waste (food and garden waste) constitutes almost 70% of the waste contained in black bags. It is for this reason that residents and businesses are encouraged to intensify

their recycling efforts and re-use their organic waste through, for instance, home composting.

Food waste can further be reduced at home through the following measures:

·Using leftover food, ensuring that it is refrigerated within 2 hours of being cooked.

·Setting your fridge to the correct temperature (1°C – 5°C).

•Noting that the "Use-by" date shows when food is no longer safe to eat. The "Best-before" date shows when the food is at its best quality.

While e-waste (electrical and electronic equipment waste) constitutes only 0.9% of the waste contained in all refuse bags, the general public is encouraged to make use of e-waste collectors within the Bergrivier Municipal Area, to dispose of this specific type of waste. This practice can further reduce waste going to landfill sites.

"It is possible to reduce our waste by nearly 70% if we simply practice recycling," concluded Van Zyl. The Municipality requires the full support of its residents, businesses and farmers, in its efforts to reduce waste going to the regional landfill sites.



WATER TREATMENT WORKS GETS R15 MILLION UPGRADES

One of Bergrivier Municipality's largest capital projects for the 2024-2025 financial year, the upgrading and rehabilitation of the Water Treatment Works in Piketberg, is nearly complete.

The project, which commenced in May 2024 and is valued at more than R15 million, has already received significant upgrades to the facility which includes: Refurbishment of the abstraction pump station; upgrading of the sludge drying beds; upgrading of access platforms at existing settling tanks; installation of new lime dosing equipment; extension of final potable water pump station; modification of laboratory / office; and other site works.

According to Leon Janse van Rensburg, Manager: Project Management at Bergrivier Municipality, the practical completion of all upgrades is expected before 13 December 2024. He added that the project is about 95% complete.

The aim is to increase the treatment capacity of the facility, and to comply with Blue Drop requirements set by the Department of Water and Sanitation.

Following the completion of the new 4ML reservoir in Piketberg, the bulk water infrastructure in Piketberg will now ensure that the Municipality can comply with its statutory obligations. The obligation is to provide sufficient potable water of a high quality and quantity to consumers on a sustainable basis. Janse van Rensburg explained that a considerable section of the main feeder pipelines in the reticulation network in the town, has also been replaced with new high-density polyethylene pipes. "It's expected that after these replacements, incidents of water pipe bursts or breaks will be minimal," he concluded.

With the completion of all these upgrades, residents can expect mostly uninterrupted water services.

In his free time, he enjoys reading, tackling DIY projects at home, and spending quality time with his boys. Family time, especially on weekends, is something he cherishes at most.



DECEMBER 2024 PAGE 13 NEWLY APPOINTED RISK OFFICER SAYS "EARLY RISK IDENTIFICATION" WILL ENHANCE SERVICES

"Every decision we make and action we take impacts the community we serve."

These were the words of Kungeka Akona Mpahlwa, the newly appointed Risk Officer of Bergrivier Municipality, who assumed office on 1 October 2024. She mentioned that addressing the challenges posed by the Strategic Risk Register is one of her top priorities. Working closely with all Directorates to facilitate positive spin-offs for the Municipality, she added, is another venture that will bear fruit for the organisation.

Mpahlwa was born in 1988 in Idutywa (Mbashe Local Municipal region) and completed her Grade 12 at Idutywa School of Excellence in 2004. She then furthered her studies at Walter Sisulu University in East London, obtaining a National Higher Certificate in Accountancy in 2009 and a National Diploma in Internal Auditing in 2010. "Currently, I'm a student at the University of South Africa doing an Advanced Diploma in Accounting Sciences. I love learning new skills and gaining valuable knowledge in my field of expertise. It sharpens my ability to perform at work," said Akona.

Her career began in the banking sector at First National Bank (FNB), where she developed her customer service skills and gained an understanding of the importance placed on compliance within a highly-regulated work environment. In 2014, she landed her first job in local government at the Amahlathi Local Municipality as an Accountant for Property Rates, eventually moving to the Internal Audit Unit. Hereafter, Mpahlwa decided to make a career move to Langeberg Municipality as an Internal Auditor. At Langeberg Municipality, Akona cultivated a keen interest in risk management, before joining Bergrivier Municipality.

As the Risk Officer, Mpahlwa's main focus will be analyzing both strategic and operational risks within the organisation and advising the leadership of Bergrivier Municipality on strategies to mitigate these risks. "It's important that we are able to identify potential risks as early as possible, so that we can implement the necessary controls and avoid facing any serious challenges to our organisation," said Akona.

A key initiative she would like to introduce is an internal monitoring and reporting channel for fraud and corruption, including the establishment of a whistleblowing hotline. This system would:

•Provide for early identification of fraud and corruption; •Promote accountability and reinforce the importance of ethical behavior;

•Protect public resources and improve operational efficiency; and

·Strengthen community trust and foster a culture of ethics.

Beyond her professional commitments, Akona enjoys exploring the internet for new information, spending time outdoors, and cooking for her family, where she loves experimenting with new recipes. "I understand everyone normally says that the town is so clean, but I also noticed here are no informal settlements in the area. That in itself is quite remarkable," she said.

"I encourage all staff to actively participate in identifying potential risks and opportunities to enhance our services to our communities," concluded Akona.

NEGENDE SKOON OUDIT IN 'N RY VIR BERGRIVIER MUNISIPALITEIT

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het onlangs uitstekende nuus ontvang vanaf die Ouditeur-Generaal van Suid-Afrika wat in sy finale verslag aangedui het dat die munisipaliteit vir 'n negende agtereenvolgende finansiële jaar (2023-2024) 'n skoon oudit ontvang het.

"Ons is baie trots oor ons jongste skoon oudit status. Dit vereis groot dissipline, professionaliteit, harde werk, deursettingsvermoë en uitsonderlike spanwerk om sulke prestasies te behaal. Ons is ongelooflik trots op ons bekwame personeel en toegewyde raadslede wat regtig hul bes doen om Bergrivier Munisipaliteit een van die beste plaaslike regerings in Suid-Afrika te maak," het Raadsheer Ray van Rooy, Uitvoerende Burgemeester van Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, gesê.

Die finale ouditverslag deur die onafhanklike Ouditeur-Generaal is op 29 November 2024 ontvang. Alhoewel dit uiters belangrik is dat die Munisipaliteit nege skoon oudits in 'n ry verwerf het, voeg Van Rooy by, bly die fokus steeds op uitsonderlike dienslewering aan alle gemeenskappe binne die Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied. Bergrivier se visie is: "'n Vooruitstrewende gemeenskap waar almal wil leef, werk, leer en speel op 'n menswaardige manier."

Alle munisipaliteite word jaarliks geoudit tussen Julie en November. Net 34 uit 257 kon in 2023 skoon oudits behaal.

'n Span ouditeure het die afgelope vier maande 'n intensiewe evaluering van Bergrivier Munisipaliteit se prestasiebestuurstelsels, finansiële state, interne beheermaatreëls, 'governance' en leierskap gedoen.

Die ouditverslag vorm deel van die Jaarverslag en sal ingevolge Artikel 127(2) van die Wet op Munisipale Finansiële Bestuur (Wet 56 van 2003) tydens die Raadsvergadering op 21 Januarie 2025 bespreek word.

CLOSURE OF MUNICIPAL OFFICES DURING THE FESTIVE SEASON 2024/25:

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 21 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act (Act 32 of 2000) that the following arrangements will be in effect during the festive season:

- 1. That the municipal offices within the boundaries of Bergrivier Municipality will be closed from 27 December 2024 to 3 January 2025;
- 2. That the Libraries within the boundaries of Bergrivier Municipality will be closed from 27 December 2024 to 3 January 2025;
- 3. That the Traffic Offices (E-Natis transactions) within the boundaries of Bergrivier Municipality will be closed from 27 December to 31 December 2024;
- 4. That the municipal services mentioned hereunder will remain open and will be available from 27 December to 2 January 2025 from 07:30 to 13:00 (excluding cashier points);
 - 4.1 All cashiers will be open and will close at 12:00, **excluding** all Beach Resorts which will operate as per normal (full work day);
 - 4.2 That pre-paid electricity standby service and essential services will be operating full-time;
- 5. That standby services will be delivered for the following: Disaster Management, Water, Sewerage and pre-paid electricity;
- 6. That refuse removal, cleaning, traffic, law enforcement as well as fire services will be delivered as per normal and that all beach resorts will be fully operational;
- 7. That special leave be granted to all employees (excluding those employed in the abovementioned services (paragraph 4.1 to 4.2 and 5) from 27 December 2024 to 3 January 2025;
- 8. That permanent employees who will be working during the abovementioned special leave period (27 December 2024 to 3 January 2025) must take their special leave (5 work days) before 30 June 2025;
- That the Traffic Offices in Piketberg and Velddrif will be open to the public on Saturday, 14 December 2024 from 08:00 until 13:00 for E-Natis transactions (excluding roadworthiness);
- 10. That the municipal offices will close on Tuesday, 24 December 2024 at 10:00; and
- 11. That all municipal services will resume in full on 6 January 2025 at 07:30.
