HERWINNING KAN BERGMUN MILJOENE SPAAR

Bergvriever Munisipaliteit spandeer ongeveer R46 miljoen per jaar aan vullisverwydering wat hoofsaaklik spandeer word aan die aankoop van vullissakke, vervoer - en stortingskostes.

Sowat R10 miljoen is slegs vir die vervoer van swartsakke na die stortingsterreine. Dié Munisipaliteit het geen gelisensieerde stortingsterreine nie en vervoer alle huishoudelike vullis na stortingsterreine in Malmesbury en Vredenburg in terme van ooreenkoms met Swartland - en Saldanhabaai Munisipaliteite.

Die herwinning van herbruikbare afval vorm deel van die Munisipaliteit se aktiwiteite wat nie net die koste van die verwydering van huishoudelike afval aansienlik kan verlaag nie, maar ook ons omgewing beskerm, skoon hou, bewaar en volhoubaar maak.

Volgens Jaco Breunissen, Bestuurder: Siviele Ingenieurswese, wil die munisipaliteit graag hê dat alle inwoners slegs nie-herwinbare items weggooi in hul swartsakke en eerder probeer om alle herwinbare items soos plastiek, blikke, aluminium en karton in die deurskynende sak te plaas. "As elke huishouding in die Bergvriever Munisipale Gebied hul swartsakafval per week met die helfte kan verminder, sal die Munisipaliteit sowat R5 miljoen op vervoer kostes kan bespaar," het Breunissen gesê. Hierdie besparing kan dan vir ander belangrike diensleweringsprojekte aangewend word.

STORTING: Bergrivier Munisipaliteit vervoer elke maand 180 vragsmotors vol swartsakke na die stortingssterreine in Malmesbury en Vredenburg. In die 2022-2023 finansiële jaar het die Munisipaliteit meer as 2500 ritte na die streekstortingssterreine gemaak om afval af te laai.


Bergrivier Munisipaliteit moet verseker dat teen 2027, 100% van alle organiese afval omgeskakel word na kompostering of houtversnippering, en nie by die streekstortingssterreine gestort word nie.

In die 2019 Bergrivier Geïntegreerde Afvalbestuursplan, is 'n steekproef gedoen om uit te vind watter soort materiaal in swartsakke weggegooi word.

Die uitslae (*sien grafiek hieronder*) dui aan dat omrent 50% van alle items wat weggegooi word herwinbare materiaal is en nie in die swartsak behoort te wees nie.

Herwinbare materiaal soos plastiek, papier, karton, metale en glas hoort in die deurskynende sak wat elke huishouding weekliks kan uitsit.

Indien u 'n verskil wil maak in u omgewing en gemeenskap, neem die regte besluite vandag. Laat ons begin om herwinning 'n deel te maak van ons daaglikske roetine. Saam sal ons nie net miljoene vir die Munisipaliteit bespaar nie, maar, meer belangrik, sal ons fokus wees op bewaring vir ons toekomstige inwoners. Ons dien en herwin met trots in Bergrivier!



BERGMUN MOURNS THE PASSING OF CECIL DAVIDS

"An entrepreneurial spirit whom will never be forgotten for his passion and drive to empower people to get their businesses off the ground".

So says Adv. Hanlie Linde, Municipal Manager at Bergrivier Municipality, who recalled some of her fondest memories with the late Cecil Davids, former Head: Strategic Services at Bergrivier Municipality.

The late Cecil Davids (56), born in Mamre, passed away on Saturday, 20 February 2024.

Davids dedicated his life to serving the public and held various positions at local authorities such as the City of Cape Town, Theewaterskloof Municipality and Bergrivier Municipality. He specialised in the following areas: Local Economic Development, Small Micro Medium Enterprises (SMME), Informal Trading, and public participation.

The Executive Mayor, Alderman Ray van Rooy, mentioned that Davids was incredibly passionate about his work within the community. "He loved being out there on the ground, engaging with local entrepreneurs and helping them grow their small businesses," said Van Rooy.

He emphasised the fact that he will be sorely missed by all staff and Councillors at the Municipality.



Filicia Erasmus, a close former colleague of Cecil in the Strategic Services Department, mentioned that he was an exceptional person. "Since the first day I started working in this department, he made me feel welcome and at ease. He was an incredibly good-hearted man. I could always enter his office if I needed help," said Erasmus.

She concluded with these words: "I will forever remember him for being the strong, strict, helpful, stylish and big-hearted person that he was," concluded Erasmus.

Davids assumed office at Bergrivier Municipality on 1 June 2016 and eventually retired seven years later on 31 July 2023 due to health challenges.



FASE 2 VAN JEUGSENTRUM IN PIKETBERG IN AANBOU

Daar word deurentyd verskeie menings gelig en vrae gevra oor die voltooiing van die Pietie Fredericks Jeugsentrum in Piketberg.

Fase 1 van die sentrum is befonds en voltooi deur PPC op 31 Oktober 2022, maar addisionele fondse moes bekom word om die res van die sentrum te voltooi. Gedeeltes van die addisionele fondse is bewillig deur die Wes-Kaap Provinciale Regering.

Jeugdiges gebruik tans 'n gedeelte van die sentrum, hoewel toegangsbeheer toegepas word. Die E-sentrum (rekenaarkamer) is reeds operasioneel in een van die eenhede. SASSA gebruik tydelik een van die eenhede (tot hulle kantore opgegrader is) en die nasorgprogram word aangebied in 'n ander eenheid, bewillig deur Steenebrug Plase. Die groot saal is tans nie beskikbaar vir gebruik nie, as gevolg van die konstruksiewerk wat gedoen word.


Die beplanning met die huidige beskikbare fondse is om die geboue in fase 2 klaar te hê voor Junie 2024.

Verdere befondsing sal bekom moet word om die sentrum in totaliteit te voltooi. Die grootste gedeelte van die Jeugsentrum sal dus nog in die volgende maande 'n konstruksieperseel wees en toegang sal slegs vanaf Gousblomstraat moontlik wees.

Belangrike gesprekke vind intussen plaas met verskeie rolspelers om te verseker dat die Jeugsentrum na voltooiing gebruik sal word vir opleiding van ons jeugdiges en om te verseker dat hulle oor vaardighede beskik wat vir hulle werk sal kan verseker.

BERGRIVIER WELCOMES NEWLY APPOINTED CFO

"As accountants, we believe that the heartbeat of any organisation is the finance department, so I treat it as such".

So says Pieter Willem Erasmus, the newly appointed Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of Bergvrievier Municipality, who assumed office as of 01 February 2024.

Erasmus went on to say that if the finance department does not execute its functions properly, it will limit the Municipality's funds to do the work as stated in Section 152 & 153 in the Constitution of South Africa. "My role as head of department is to provide the necessary financial guidance and support to the other directorates, and in so doing, making a difference within the communities we serve. It brings me great joy to assist officials to drive service delivery to exceptional standards".

Erasmus (41) was born in Cape Town, but moved to Merweville in the Central Karoo, where he grew up and lived for most of his life.

He obtained a B-Tech Degree in Internal Auditing from the Cape Peninsula University of Technology (CPUT) in 2006. A year later (2007), Erasmus began working for PFK South Africa, an audit firm in Cape Town, where he gained three (3) years' work experience in their tax department. He later moved to a different department within the firm, to hone his craft in external auditing and soon after completed his articles through the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA). Erasmus is currently enrolled for an Honours Degree in Public Administration at Stellenbosch University, however, his main goal is to obtain a Master's Degree in Public Administration.

In 2013, due to personal reasons, Erasmus had to leave Cape Town and move back to his hometown in Merweville, to support his family with their farming operations. Later that year, Erasmus landed a job at Prince Albert Municipality as the first Accountant in their Budget and Treasury Office, which led to their first ever clean audit.

In 2020, Erasmus became the Chief Financial Officer at Living Lands, a Non-profitable Organisation, which specialises in farming activities in the Baviaanskloof and Langkloof areas. "Their biggest contributor of donations came from the Netherlands and I really enjoyed the collaboration between the sponsors and farmers. I realised that my passion, other than farming, resides within the public sector," said Erasmus.

In March 2022, he became the Chief Financial Officer at Prince Albert Municipality at the age of 39, however, ended his chapter in the Central Karoo two years later after accepting an opportunity at Bergvrievier Municipality to be their new CFO.

Erasmus still enjoys being part of a farming community, however, his first priority is and will always be his family. Outside of his busy schedule, he loves spending quality time with his wife and two daughters. "I grew up on a farm so I regard myself as fortunate, hence me being somewhat active in that sector. I also enjoy being active and use it as a stress reliever," said Erasmus.

RED TIDE WARNING

A potential red tide incident was noted in January 2024 along the Bergrivier Municipal coastline and the Berg Estuary.

A red tide is a phenomenon caused by algal blooms during which algae grows excessively that they discolor coastal waters (hence the name "red tide"). The algal bloom may also deplete oxygen in the waters and release toxins that may cause illness in humans and other animals. This can result in fish mortalities and rock lobster walkouts on the beaches and estuary banks, which is a high health risk to humans and the environment.

If you eat seafood contaminated with toxins, neurological symptoms may occur and become serious.

The beach is safe to walk on. People are advised not to collect & eat washed up fish & shellfish. The water is safe to swim in, but we suggest that care be taken when walking in the shallow side, there's a lot of dead fish with spines (e.g. seabarbers and stingrays).

There's more dead creatures in the water than outside of it.

Be safe and take care.

'n Potensiële rooigety-voorval langs die Bergrivier Municipale kuslyn en die Bergriviermonding is in January 2024 opgemerk.

'n Rooigety is 'n verskynsel wat veroorsaak word deur algebloei waartydens alge oormatig groei dat hulle kuswaters verkleur. Die algebloei kan ook suurstof in die water uitput en gifstowwe vrystel wat siektes by mense en diere kan veroorsaak. Dit kan lei tot dooie visse en kreef wat uitstap op die strand en oewer van die riviermonding, wat 'n hoë gesondheidsrisiko vir mense en die omgewing inhoud.

Indien u seekos eet wat gifstowwe besmet is, kan neurologiese simptome voorkom en ernstig word.

Die strand is veilig om op te stap. Mense word aangeraai om nie uitgespoelde vis en skulpvis te versamel en te eet nie. Die water is veilig om in te swem, maar ons stel voor dat u versigtig moet wees wanneer u in die vlak water loop, daar is baie dooie visse met stekels (bv. seebarbers en stingrays).

Daar is meer dooie wesens in die water as daarbuite.

Wees veilig.




