BERG RIVER ESTUARY IN VELDDRIF: NOW A SITE OF INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE

"There is only one earth and one Berg River Estuary".

These were the words of Western Cape Premier, Alan Winde, who delivered the keynote address at the launch of Berg River Estuary as a Ramsar Site on 05 June 2022, ahead of World Environment Day.

The Berg River Estuary spans over 61km² and is one of the largest in the country. With the estuary receiving Ramsar status, it is now recognised worldwide as a site of ecological importance. Some 127 species of waterbird have been detected since 1975, some of which are globally threatened such as the Cape Cormorant.

The Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, Ald. Ray van Rooy, expressed his excitement about the prospects that a Ramsar site in the region would have on the local economy and especially the tourism industry. "This is a celebration for all of us in the Bergrivier Municipal Area. This estuary attracts bird watchers, joggers, canoeists, tourists, nature conservationists, nature lovers, and also individuals who are planning to settle in the region. It is an important ecological space and we need to keep the balance between protecting this sacred area and reaping the economic benefits that it brings," said Van Rooy.

"Dit is belangrik dat ons jeug 'n geleentheid kry om persoonlik met verteenwoordigers van verskeie tersiêre instellings, ander onderrig instansies en voornemende werkgewers te skakel. Dit sal hulle help om die regte keuses vir hul toekoms te maak".

Dit was die woorde van Uitvoerende Burgemeester, Rdh. Ray van Rooy. So het hy die belangrikheid beklemtoon om die verskillende studiegeleenthede, beursopsies en vereistes ten toon te stel wat nodig is vir leerders om suksesvol vir hul verlangde graad, diploma of hoë sertifikaat in te skryf.

Leerders van verskeie dorpe binne die Bergrivier Municipale Area het op 29 Julie 2022 'n jaarlike opedag, LoTYDE, in Piketberg bygewoon om meer inligting oor hul verlangde loopbaan te kry.

LoTYDE is 'n akrooniem vir 'Leaders of Tomorrow Youth Development Expo'. Dit verwys na die laagwater van die see (stiltetyd) wat teenwoordig is voordat die hoogwater intree. Dit is in 'n sekere sin simbolies dat skool die oefenterrein is wat leerders voorberei om 'n sukses van hul lewens te maak wanneer hulle die "wêreld buite" betree. LoTYDE is in 2015 gestig deur die Kantoor van die Uitvoerende Burgemeester met die ondersteuning van die Departement van Onderwys en word befonds deur Bergrivier Municipality.

Dié geleentheid, wat vir hoërskoolleerders tussen graad 11 en 12 voorsiening maak, is by die Steynville Primêre skoolsaal in Piketberg aangebied. Die Premier van die Wes-Kaap, Alan Winde, het 'n spesiale gasverskyning gemaak om die jeug aan te moedig om beheer oor hul lewens te neem en die geleenthede wat gebied word, aan te gryp.



Leerders van die volgende hoërskole het dit bygewoon: Hoërskool Piketberg, Porterville Hoërskool, Steynville Sekonder en Hoërskool Velddrif. Daar was verskillende stalletjies wat bestaan het uit verskeie onderwysinstellings wat Kaapse Skiereiland Universiteit van Tegnologie, Universiteit van Wes-Kaapland, Universiteit van Suid-Afrika, Onafhanklike Verkiesingskommissie (OVK), Gene Louw Verkeerskollege, CTU Training College en Weskus Kollege ingesluit het.

Van Rooy het genoem dat hierdie geleentheid ontwerp is om leerders te help met een van die mees fundamentele besluite wat hulle ter ondersteuning van hul loopbane moet neem. "Die realiteit is dat daar geen tersiêre fasilitate binne die Bergrivier Municipale Area is nie, en baie van hierdie onderwysinstellings is redelik ver weg wat dit vir die meeste leerders baie moeilik maak om verder te studeer," het hy verduidelik.

Vanjaar het die opspraakwekkende groep genaamd Aidam-John en Lil' Willy die leerders vermaak deur van hul gewildste liedjies te sing, en die verhoog opgehelder met hul danspassies en energie.

Ashley Pienaar, seremoniemeester, het die gehoor vermaak met sy unieke komiese optredes en die skare op hul voete gehou. Daar was ook verskeie gelukkige trekking-pryse (elektroniese toestelle) wat deur leerders gewen is. Elke leerder het 'n handelsmerk LoTYDE rugsakkie ontvang wat 'n waterbottel, 'n flitsie, gebottelde water, versnapperinge en 'n skoonmaaktoestel vir 'n selfoon bevat het.

BERG RIVER ESTUARY NOW A RAMSAR SITE OF INTERNATIONAL ECOLOGICAL IMPORTANCE



Die Bergrivier Stap en Trap Initiatief het op 01 Augustus 2022 in Piketberg afgeskop. Die deelnemers het deur elke dorp binne Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied gestap en getrap. Hulle het meer as 300km gedek.

Die doel van die inisiatief is om bewusmaking in die Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied te kweek teen dwelm - en alkoholmisbruik, seksuele uitbuiting, tienerswangerskappe, geslagsgebaseerde geweld, diefstal van Munisipale eiendom en die oprigting van dwelmhuse. VANDALISM & THEFT OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY OUT OF CONTROL IN VELDDRIF

"We are coming for you!"

"Vandalism, theft or destruction of municipal property will not be tolerated in Bergrivier Municipality. We will find you. We will clamp down on all perpetrators".

These were the words from Rhandal Swarts, Speaker of Bergrivier Municipality, who sent a serious message to all individuals who are interfering with municipal service delivery efforts in Velddrif. The Office of the Speaker convened an urgent meeting with safety role-players in August 2022, to discuss stringent measures that will be implemented to halt all incidences of vandalism.

Bergrivier Municipality spent approximately R1,5 million during the 2020-2021 financial year in Velddrif alone, to repair damaged municipal infrastructure and to replace stolen cables. "Vandalism is at crisis level. It has become an annual expense weighing heavy on the budget, eroding opportunities to spend funds where it matters most," said Swarts.

The Municipality, in partnership with safety stakeholders, is busy drafting a high-level plan to combat vandalism and theft of municipal property across the Bergrivier Municipal Area, but more specifically in the hotspot areas (Velddrif).



Swarts is urging all residents to report incidences of vandalism or theft of municipal property immediately to the Municipality.

"Take ownership of municipal facilities, its yours. We have to work together to combat this scourge in our communities. Services are interrupted when criminal activities like these are left unattended. We need to act and act fast," said Swarts.

Any person who reports an incident of vandalism or cable theft to the Municipality may be rewarded if the information or evidence provided directly leads an individual being found guilty of the crime committed.



These protests led to the death of many young children, including Hector Pieterson.
