NUWE RESERVOIR IN PIKETBERG 80% VOLTOOID

"Ons is ongelooflik trots en opgewonde oor hierdie projek, aangesien water die lewensbron van enige dorp of gemeenskap is. Dit is 'n groot suksesverhaal vir Piketberg en die versekering van volhoubare voorsiening van vars water vir ons inwoners is uitstekende nuus vir toekomstige beleggers ook."

Só het Adv. Hanlie Linde, Munisipale Bestuurder van Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, gedurende 'n belangrike gesprek oor verskeie kapitaalprojekte, gesê.

Hierdie nuwe reservoir, wat R18,6 miljoen beloop, sal addisionele stoorkapasiteit byvoeg tot die reeds bestaande twee reservoirs in Piketberg. Die huidige twee reservoirs stoor ongeveer 5,7 megaliter water. Saam sal al drie reservoirs 'n totaal van 9,7 megaliter water kan stoor.

Linde sê sy is tevrede met die vordering van die projek tot op hede ten spyte van die weersomstandighede wat in June/Julie 2023 ervaar is. Vorderingsverlae deur die Kontrakteur dui aan dat die bou van die dak van die reservoir in September (2023) sal begin.

Arthur Willemse, Assistent Projek Bestuurder by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, lê klem op die feit dat die volhoubare voorsiening van drink water gedurende die warm somermaande nie onderbreek sal word as gevolg van stoorkapasiteit nie. Daar is ander uitdagings soos langdurige beurtkrag en onvoorsiene waterpype wat bars, waaraan steeds aandag gegee word.

Daar word verwag dat die nuwe reservoir in Piketberg teen November 2023 voltooi sal wees.

LOTYDE INSPIRES LEARNERS TO PRIORITIZE EDUCATION

"Youth development is a priority for Bergrivier Municipality. LoTYDE introduces our youth to various tertiary institutions and prospective employers, ultimately broadening their knowledge, allowing them to make well informed career choices".

These were the words of Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, who emphasized the importance of showcasing the different study opportunities, bursary options and the specific requirements to successfully enroll for their desired degree, diploma, or higher certificate at the institution of their choice.

On Friday, 21 July 2023, approximately 550 learners from the various high schools within the Bergrivier Municipal Area attended the open day at the Steynville Primary School Hall in Piketberg. The expo prioritizes learners between grade 11 and 12 to motivate and encourage them to further their education.

LoTYDE has a symbolic meaning as this acronym stands for 'Leaders of Tomorrow Youth Development Expo', referring to the low tide of the ocean whereby our youth receive the necessary preparation during their high school years. This program is also aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's), ensuring quality education for everyone. Through continuous support and contributions by the Department of Education, LoTYDE was established in 2015, being driven by the Office of the Executive Mayor, expands annually. Representatives from the following schools were present: Piketberg High School, Steynville Secondary School and Velddrif High School. Various higher education institutions such as West Coast College, Gene Louw Traffic College, and the University of Stellenbosch, showcased some of the courses and bursaries they have on offer. Nedbank were present to assist the leaners with relevant information regarding the different accounts they can open and save with, while Western Cape Government

provided the learners with information on their bursary opportunities and learnership programmes.

"The reality is that there aren't any tertiary facilities within the Bergrivier Municipal Area, some learners don't have access to internet or a computer to do proper research, resulting in many of them not being able submit their applications," explained Van Rooy.

The new music sensation "Ricky vani Frontline" entertained the learners with some of his most popular songs. His comedic colleague Ashwin Martin, had a mouthful to say as always, having everyone in stitches.

Ashley Pienaar, master of ceremonies and motivational speaker, rocked the stage with his unique comedic performances and kept the crowd on their feet and their eyes glued to the stage. Several learners won some exciting prizes (electronic devices) through lucky draws.

Every learner received a branded LoTYDE goodie bag which contained snacks and electronic devices.

MINISTERS TABLE OPTIONS TO RESOLVE TRUCK ISSUE IN VELDDRIF

The conduct of the heavy truck haulers on the road has become a growing concern for the communities of Velddrif and Dwarskersbos.

The Provincial Minister of Mobility, Ricardo Mackenzie, along with the Provincial Minister of Infrastructure, Tertius Simmers, held a public meeting with residents of Velddrif and Dwarskersbos on 30 August 2023, to not only respond to numerous complaints regarding the constant heavy truck traffic moving through the town, but to also present their possible solutions.

According to a media release from the Western Cape Department of Infrastructure, both ministers presented the public with the short and medium-term plans to resolve the increased truck traffic and concerns with the road infrastructure.

The Dwarskersbos and Velddrif communities have seen a massive increase in truck traffic which can be linked to the growing mining sector in the neighbouring regions. The communities raised their concerns with Bergrivier Municipality, that then took their concerns to the Western Cape Government as the roads are provincial roads.

Minister Ricardo Mackenzie mentioned that the shortterm solution would start from 31 August 2023. "Our traffic teams will embark on special traffic law enforcement operations at key identified locations. We are the only province in the country with a 24-hour traffic law enforcement presence so these special operations will run continuously. The communities can rest assured that operators who contravene the traffic laws will meet the long arm of the law. We also urge the corporate sector to show leadership with their freight operations. To ensure that trucks are not overloaded, and drivers are not speeding or using routes that do not Minister Simmers explained to the public that he presented both the medium and long-term solutions to the Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, Alderman Ray van Rooy for consideration by the Municipality.

"The construction of the replacement of the Carinus Bridge is planned and envisaged to commence within the Medium-Term Expenditure Framework (MTREF). Part of the project will be the upgrade of the R27 and R399 in Velddrif," said Simmers.

"While we will continue with our regular planned maintenance operations, this project will see an upgrade in the road infrastructure suitable to accommodate traffic volume expansions in the future," Simmers concluded.

Simmers also mentioned that the long-term option for the Municipality to consider is to start a de-proclamation process to change Voortrekker Road from a provincial road to a local road. By doing this, the Municipality will then have greater control over its traffic rules for vehicles.

Both the Municipality and Provincial Government are committed to keeping the affected communities informed of all the latest developments regarding this matter.

NEW PRE-PAID ELECTRICITY METER SYSTEM FOR BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY

In November 2024, the 20-digit token identifier, which can be seen on all pre-paid electricity meters within the Bergrivier Municipal Area and in the rest of South Africa, will expire and seize to accept any electricity tokens.

Residents who are using Standard Transfer Specification (STS) pre-paid electricity meters will therefore not be able to buy electricity unless their meters have been reprogrammed.

To ensure a smooth continuation of your pre-paid electricity service, Bergrivier Municipality will follow a specific schedule per area, whereby it will phase in the reprogramming of customers pre-paid meters.

The first phase of this project will commence on Monday, 18 September 2023 in Porterville. The Municipality will visit other areas as from October 2023. The details of the visitations will be communicated via the Municipality's various social media platforms.

Consumers with conventional credit meters will not be affected by this new pre-paid electricity system.

The following questions which pre-paid consumers might have will be addressed in detail in the weeks to come, such as:

- How do you know whether you meter has been reprogrammed?
- What happens if I lose my tokens will I be able to get the two 20 digit codes again?
- Can I still buy pre-paid electricity from banking apps?
- Can I update my meter before the Municipality visits my area?

Martin Crous, Manager: Income at Bergrivier Municipality said: "We urge all pre-paid electricity customers to kindly cooperate with the Municipality during the upgrading of their pre-paid electricity meter, to ensure that they will not experience any challenges. The last thing we want is a customer trying to punch in a token and their prepaid electricity meter not accepting it".

If you'd like to have your pre-paid electricity meter upgraded urgently, you are more than welcome to contact Mr. Vincent Esau, Accountant: Credit Control at 022 913 6108.

Remember this before reprogramming your prepaid meter:

You must ensure that you enter all your unused electricity tokens into your meter before you start the upgrade. If you do not enter your electricity tokens first (unused), you will not be able to use them after the upgrade has concluded.

Please note: No refunds will be made on tokens not punched into your prepaid meter after the upgrade is done.


If you have successfully punched in your unused electricity tokens before the upgrade, you will still be able to use those units after the upgrade.



MAYORAL SOCCER CUP DRAWS BIG SUPPORT IN VELDDRIF

"Soccer is alive in Bergrivier Municipality. Well done to all the players and especially the winning clubs who performed exceptionally well on the pitch at this year's Bergrivier Mayoral Soccer Cup."

These were the words of Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, who attended the Bergrivier Mayoral Soccer Cup which was held at the Eric Goldsmith Sports Ground in Velddrif. This event took place on Freedom Day, 27 April 2023.

A total of 8 teams from across Bergrivier Municipality, namely Piketberg Spurs FC, Atlantic Rovers FC, Young Stars FC, Young Chiefs FC, Porterville Hotspurs FC, Yizo Yizo FC, Piketberg United FC and Rasta Milan FC participated in this competition.

On a cold and misty Thursday morning (27 April 2023), approximately 300 spectators made their way to the stadium to support their favourite local soccer club. The Mayoral Soccer Cup was designed to create a platform to allow players an opportunity to showcase their talents and empower local clubs by offering a financial incentive to the top performing teams.

The tournament consisted of two divisions, namely Division A (South African Breweries League) and Division B (Local Football Association League). The final rankings for Division A (from top) were Atlantic Rovers FC (R8 000); Yizo Yizo FC (R4 000); Young Chiefs FC (R2 000) and Rasta Milan FC (R1 000), whilst Young Stars FC (R8 000) won Division B and in second place was Piketberg United FC (R4 000). Third place in Division B went to Porterville Hotspurs FC (R2 000) and in fourth was Piketberg Spurs FC (R1 000). Emotions were high as all teams battled it out to be crowned as the winners of the Bergrivier Mayoral Soccer Cup. Van Rooy mentioned that even though the tournament was very competitive, the clubs respected each other on the pitch and the matches were played with good energy and discipline.

The best players on the day were as follows:

- Best goalkeeper Zidan Coetzee (Division A) and Thabo Tiba (Division B);
- Best midfielder of the tournament Justine du Toit (Division A) and Emmanuel Kayster (Division B);
