Council meets the public: Bergrivier Municipality's Council approved the amendment and review of the IDP (2022-2027) as well as the 2024/25 to 2026/27 budget at a Council Meeting held on Friday, 31 May 2024 at the Allan Boesak Community Hall in Piketberg. This was the second time that the Municipality held its Council Meeting in the public domain. Speaker Alderman Rhandall Swarts chaired the Council Meeting. The Municipality would like to thank all members of the public for attending. We serve with pride!

BUDGET APPROVED BY COUNCIL FOR 2024/2025 - 2026/2027

"We understand the challenging economic times that our people are living in".

So said Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, during the delivery of his budget speech on Friday, 31 May 2024 at a Council Meeting held at the Allan Boesak Community Hall in Piketberg. This was the second time Bergrivier Municipality took its Council Meeting to the public in a community hall.

Bergrivier Municipality's budget for the 2024-2025 financial year, totalling at just over R659 million, was approved by Council.

Van Rooy mentioned that preparing the final budget was a daunting task under the current economic circumstances, both locally and globally. "In drafting this budget, all office bearers and the administration had to find a balance between affordability and the delivery of services," said Van Rooy.

There are several factors that had an impact on drafting the budget which mainly came from the macro environment, including: Global economic risks; disruption to the freight and logistics sector; persistent and prolonged loadshedding (impacting on service delivery); National government's fiscal consolidation strategy (which translates into lower government grants); and understanding that the tax and tariff payers are overburdened, creating a situation whereby municipal bills are becoming unaffordable.

Despite these challenges, the delivery of excellent services and improving the quality of life of all residents remains the number one priority for Bergrivier Municipality. The budget was drafted and aligned to the needs of the communities we serve, as documented in the approved Integrated Development Plan (2022-2027).

The approved budget consists of the following:

- Capital Budget of R75,954 million; and
- Operating Budget of R583,355 million.

Van Rooy indicated that in order to fund this budget, increasing the tariff charges were unavoidable, but it was done responsibly after much deliberation.

Tariff increases which will take effect as from 1 July 2024:

- Water increases by 6,9%;
- Electricity increases by 10,9% (Subject to NERSA's approval);
- Refuse removal increases by 20%;
- Sewerage increases by 6,9%; and
- Property Rates increases by 6,9%.

"In preparing the final budget, we also had to incorporate the guidelines provided by National Treasury. I can confirm Bergvrijer Municipality's commitment to spend economically rather than spending the economy. It will be expected of the entire administration to continue to find alternative and innovative measures of ensuring service delivery without necessarily having to increase the cost to the taxpayer and consumer", Van Rooy boldly explained.

The Municipality will continue to support the vulnerable within the communities through the implementation of indigent subsidies to qualifying households, which will receive a support package consisting of 50 free electricity units, 6 kilolitres of free water and a 100% subsidised standard household refuse removal and sewerage tariff per month.

Van Rooy concluded his speech by thanking the Budget Steering Committee under the leadership of Councillor Daniels, the Municipal Manager, the Chief Financial Officer and the staff in the Strategic Services Department and Budget Office, Directors and other personnel who were involved in compiling the budget and related documents.




PORTERVILLE HARDEST HIT BY STORMY WEATHER IN APRIL



STRONG WINDS: The wind speed recorded in Porterville on 7 April 2024 reached the 100km/h mark. The intensity of the wind was so strong that it blew over large blue gum trees, roof tops of businesses and residential homes. It took approximately three days to restore the town to its pristine state.

Porterville was hardest hit by the extreme weather conditions experienced on Sunday, 7 April 2024. The other towns were not affected by the weather in any significant way during this period.

On Sunday, 7 April 2024, the main cable that feeds Porterville with electricity sustained considerable damage (broken insulator). This led to the interruption in electricity supply to the town. Extensive damage was also caused to properties (both private and municipal buildings) and electrical infrastructure. In most cases, the roofing of houses and businesses were damaged and, in some instances, even ripped off by very strong winds. Several large trees were also blown over, some landing in the main road of Porterville, causing temporary traffic flow issues.

No injuries were reported.



It took personnel from Bergvrijer Municipality's Electrical Department about two days to restore the electricity supply to all affected households in the town.

Bergvrijer Municipality set up a temporary Joint Operations Centre at the Porterville Municipal Office, where it coordinated all local disaster incidents in the region.

The Municipality also assisted the community with Disaster Management relief materials during this period.

Winter is approaching and we therefore urge all residents to be extra careful when driving during extreme weather, and rather opt to stay indoors if at all possible, until it is safe to travel again.



JEUGUITRUILPROGRAM IN BELGIË 'N BELEWENIS

Tien leerders van vier hoëskole in die Bergvryer Munisipale Gebied onder die leiding van Alletta van Sittert (Bestuurder Strategiese Dienste), het in April 2024 België besoek as deel van die jeuguitruilingprogram tussen die twee munisipaliteite. Die program geskied binne die Verenigde Nasies se "Volhoubare Ontwikkelingsdoelwitte" (SDG).

Die internasionale ooreenkoms tussen Bergvryer Munisipaliteit en Heist-op-den-Berg Munisipaliteit is in 2014 gestig en is gebaseer op drie pilare naamlik: afvalbestuur, jeuguitruiling en publiekedeelname.

Tydens die program het die 20 leerders verskeie instellings en organisasies besoek. Dit het ingesluit, 'n besoek aan 2 van hulle Tegniese Skole, 'n museum uit die Tweede Wêreldoorlog, 'n besoek aan Gent en Brussels en verskeie jeugprogramme en gestructureerde bordspel oor die SDG's. Die leerders het ook tuis-gegaan by hulle gasgesinne waar hulle blootgestel was aan die daaglike lewe in België.

Van Sittert sê hierdie reis België toe was 'n ware belewenis vir die leerders. "Die leerders het soveel ervaring opgedoen in verskeie aktiwiteite, is blootgestel aan 'n totale nuwe kultuur en het veral baie geleer oor die onderwys-stelsel in België," het Van Sittert gesê.

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het in April 2024 elke dorp besoek om die konsep begroting en konsep Geïntegreerde Ontwikkelings Plan (GOP) met inwoners, te bespreek.

Advokaat Hanlie Linde, Munisipale Bestuurder by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, het verduidelik dat die GOP dien as 'n strategiese plan vir die ontwikkeling van die Munisipaliteit oor 'n vyfjaarperiode, waarin prioriteite, projekte en hulpbron toekennings uiteengesit word.

Sowat 550 inwoners van regoor die Bergrivier Munisipale Gebied het die geleentheid gegryp om deel te wees van hierdie belangrike gesprekke, om insae te hê op ontwikkelinge in hul gemeenskappe.

Deur die gemeenskap in hierdie proses te betrek, streef Bergrivier Munisipaliteit daarna om gemeenskapsinsae in die GOP te inkorporeer, sodat dit 'n meer akkurate weerbeelding van plaaslike prioriteite kan wees," het Linde gesê.

E-CENTRE IN PIKETBERG FULLY OPERATIONAL

"We are certain that this facility will produce highly-skilled future leaders".

So says Executive Mayor, Alderman Ray van Rooy, who highlighted the importance of creating a space for the youth to access computers and the internet, to significantly enhance their chances of excelling in the digital and knowledge era.

The Premier of the Western Cape, Alan Winde, along with the Director-General of the Western Cape, Dr. Harry Malila, and the Executive Mayor of Bergvrijer Municipality, Alderman Ray van Rooy, cut the ribbon at the E-Centre inside the Pietie Fredericks Youth Centre in Piketberg on Tuesday, 23 April 2024, officially unveiling the brand new fully-equipped E-Centre.

The delegation from the Western Cape Government were taken on a tour of the entire Youth Centre, whereby they were given insight into all the activities that will be taking place on the premises, and the different facilities that will be based here once the construction of Phase 2 has been completed. The E-Centre is just one of many services that will be on offer at the Youth Centre in Piketberg.

Van Rooy mentioned that the primary objective of this project is to "give our youth the best possible chance to find employment, work on projects, participate in computer skill courses and to dignified living". The E-Centre is divided into two sections, a training room whereby the youth can access accredited computer training, whilst the other section can be used for daily tasks such as finding a job, drafting schools projects, creating your CV or printing pages.





"This facility is our investment in the youth of Bergvrijer Municipality. I'm confident that this centre is going to produce future leaders and even successful entrepreneurs. One of our goals is to support the young people to find suitable employment opportunities, whilst capacitating themselves to be competitive in the digital space," said Wnde.

Van Rooy mentioned that youth development is a key component to the Municipality's vision of "Creating a prosperous community, where all want to live, work, learn and play in a dignified manner". "The future of Bergvrijer is in our children's hands. The importance of investing in the youth cannot be overstated, and I strongly believe that this centre will create a solid foundation for young people to learn, grow and develop into highly motivated, responsible, capable and employable citizens and leaders of tomorrow," concluded Van Rooy.

The services on offer at the E-Centre includes:

- Use of computers;
- Access to the internet;
- Access to e-mail services;
- Printing (a maximum of 10 pages per person per day);
- Basic computer training;
- Access to government information and services; and
- Accredited computer training.

WINTER SEASON: PREVENTION OF STORMWATER PROBLEMS

During the winter period, the Municipality generally receives enquiries from the public regarding stormwater blockages, which causes damage to properties. Here's how it can be resolved:

- If your property is located in a lower lying area than that of your neighbour, you are likely to receive stormwater during heavy rainfall from a higher-lying neighbouring property, as long as the flow of the stormwater remains natural;

- If the owner of a property upstream to you (neighbour) disturbs the natural flow of the stormwater, the matter must be addressed promptly between the owners;

- Stormwater can be channelled safely in different ways from higher to lower lying properties, such as, by providing underground stormwater pipes or opening stormwater channels (these channels should be cleaned on a regular basis to avoid blockages);

- If you have a boundary wall constructed between you and your neighbour, make sure that your boundary wall does not prevent the natural flow of water from the higher to the lower lying property. This can be done by creating a drainage system or to simply make a few openings in the boundary wall, to ensure the natural flow of water.

We encourage all residents to channel rainwater from their roofs to water storage tanks and / or to the street, through gutters and pipes, to prevent water flow problems from occurring. The most important thing is to discuss possible solutions to waterflow issues with your neighbour.

- Eienaar van die eiendom om 'n gesertifiseerde ID-afskrif aan te heg; en
- Heg 'n onlangse munisipale rekening aan.

Alle ander aansoekers (werkloos of werkend):

- Bewys van inkomste (betaalstrokie of bankstaat)
- Werklose individue kan hul werkloosheidsversekeringskaart aanheg kan hul werkloosheidsversekerings aanheg, saam met 'n beëdigde verklaring wat werkloosheid bevestig;
- Seisoenwerkers moet hul IRP5-vorm aanheg;
- Heg 'n onlangse munisipale rekening aan;
- Heg gesertifiseerde ID-afskrifte aan van alle individue wat op die perseel woon en ouer as 18 jaar is; en
- Heg skoolrapporte of bewys van skoolbywoning aan vir alle kinders wat op die perseel woonagtig is.

Alle kwalifiserende aansoekers sal die volgende gratis dienste ontvang:

- 50kwh elektisiteit per maand is gratis (u elektrisiteitsboks moet beperk word tot 20 ampère);
- Eerste 6kl water is gratis;
- Die basiese fooi ten opsigte van water; en
- 100 % gratis riool en vullisverwydering.

"Ek het Lita so 23 jaar gelede ontmoet as Estralita Hendricks. Sy het alles wat jy aan haar verduidelik neergeskryf, net in geval sy sou vergeet. Ek het haar ervaar as 'n vriendelike en lojale kollega".

Rudensia Dietrich (Hoof Klerk: Debiteure navrae), het Estralita jare terug ontmoet toe sy nog by Porterville Munisipaliteit gewerk het.

"Sy was 'n baie goeie werker. Altyd bereidwillig om mense te help. Sy was baie pliggetrou en lojaal teenoor haar werk en gemeenskap. Sy was 'n vriendin, kollega en suster. Sy was 'n omgee mens en het altyd met haar kollegas gedeel. Ons gaan vir Lita baie baie mis," het Dietrich afgesluit.

Ons wil ons innige meegevoel betuig met die familie. Ons bid dat God u krag en vertroosing sal gee gedurende hierdie moeilike periode.






