independent attorney, and during 2017, she was called to the Bar. In the very same year, Roos completed her pupillage and was admitted as an advocate of the High Court of South Africa.

Apart from being an advocate, she is also a qualified and accredited mediator. Roos is both nationally and internationally accredited as a mediator.

"Community is much more than belonging to something; it's about doing something together that makes belonging matter," is one of her favourite quotes from Brian Solis.
