## VELDDRIF WASTE FACILITY: CLEAN-UP OPERATIONS UNDERWAY

Bergrivier Municipality is aware of concerns recently raised by members of the Velddrif community regarding the state of the Velddrif Waste Facility and its surrounding area.

The Municipality takes these concerns seriously and remains committed to maintaining safe, clean and well-managed waste services for all residents.

Following a site inspection conducted in January 2026 and engagements with staff on-site, it was identified that a significant portion of the waste found outside the facility perimeter is the result of illegal dumping, as well as waste being left in undesignated areas rather than inside the facility.

### Immediate Action Underway

In response, the Municipality has taken decisive steps to address the situation. Since 5 February 2026, eight temporary workers have been appointed to focus specifically on the rapid clean-up of waste that has accumulated outside the facility. Their efforts are already showing positive results, with **approximately one ton of waste being removed daily** from the area surrounding the facility. This work includes removing illegally dumped materials, clearing wind-blown litter, and restoring the surrounding area to an acceptable standard.

This intervention forms part of a broader operational plan aimed at strengthening waste management practices and improving overall site conditions.

Residents are reminded that proper use of the facility plays a critical role in maintaining a clean and healthy environment for the entire community.

# WATERPYPVERVANGINGSPROGRAM TANS AAN DIE GANG IN PORTERVILLE

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit wil inwoners herinner dat die Waterpypvervangingsprogram in Porterville, wat op 17 November 2025 begin het, tans aan die gang is en na verwagting sal voortduur tot 2 Oktober 2026.

Hierdie belangrike infrastruktuurprojek maak deel uit van die Munisipaliteit se pogings om dienslewering te verbeter en 'n betroubare, doeltreffende en volhoubare watervoorsiening aan die gemeenskap te verseker. Die program is daarop gemik om ou, verouderde waterpypleiding te vervang, waterverliese te verminder en die druk binne die stelsel te verbeter, sodat alle huishoudings in Porterville 'n stabiele watertoevoer kan geniet.

Die werk behels die vervanging van waterpype in verskeie strate, insluitend Buitengracht, Vlei, Boom, Reservoir, Kliniek, Kraan, Lang, Abbatoir, Dorp, Hoog, Disa, Eike, Sipres, Jakaranda, Pedro, Loerie, Eland en DJ Pearce, sowel as Voortrekkerweg. Die projek sluit die verwydering van ou pype, die uitgrawing en heraansluiting van huishoudelike wateraansluitings,

sowel as die herstel van geaffekteerde paaie en opritte in.

Tydlike wateronderbrekings is moontlik tydens sekere fases van die program, veral wanneer nuwe pype aan die bestaande netwerk gekoppel word. Die Munisipaliteit doen alles moontlik om hierdie onderbrekings tot die minimum te beperk, en geaffekteerde huishoudings sal vooraf kennisgewings ontvang.

# R15 MILJOEN-BELEGGING: OPGRADERING VAN PIKETBERG HOOFDSUBSTASIE NOU VOLTOOI

Bergivier Munisipaliteit het meer as R15 miljoen belê in die opgradering van die hoofsubstasie in Piketberg, met die suksesvolle voltooiing van die finale fase van die projek op 4 Februarie 2026. Hierdie belangrike belegging verseker 'n meer betroubare en volhoubare elektrisiteitsvoorsiening vir inwoners, besighede en toekomstige ontwikkeling in die dorp.

Die opgradering het oor drie-fase gestrek, waarvan die laaste fase nou suksesvol afgehandel is. As deel van die finale werk is ou toerusting vervang met nuwe, moderne skakeltoerusting wat meer betroubaar, veiliger en omgewingsvriendelik is.

Volgens Jan Erasmus, Bestuurder: Elektriese Ingenieursdienste by Bergivier Munisipaliteit, stel die opgegradeerde substasie die munisipaliteit in staat om toekomstige netwerkuitbreiding moontlik te maak.

“Die nuwe toerusting maak dit makliker om krag vinniger te herstel tydens onderhoud, sodat inwoners gouer weer elektrisiteit kan hê. Hierdie opgradering verleng ook die lewensduur van die substasie met 30 jaar en ondersteun verdere behuisingontwikkelings sowel as die groeiende ekonomie van Piketberg,” sê Erasmus.

Die opgraderings help ook om toekomstige elektrisiteitsbehoefte te voorsien, insluitend 'n toekomstige opgradering van die Notified Maximum Demand (NMD) by Eskom, waarvoor 'n aansoek tans aanhangig is.

Bergivier Munisipaliteit het bevestig dat daar ook planne is om dele van die hoofsubstasies in Velddrif en Porterville op te gradeer as deel van die munisipaliteit se plan om in essensiële infrastruktuur te belê.

# BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY WELCOMES NEWLY APPOINTED MANAGER: CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES

“To strategically plan, manage and implement infrastructure that accommodates future growth, while ensuring sustainable and reliable basic service delivery to all residents of the Greater Bergrivier Area.”

These were the words of the newly appointed Manager in the Technical Services Directorate of Bergrivier Municipality, Errol Witbooi, who recently joined the Team.

Witbooi emphasized his commitment to strengthening service delivery through sound technical planning, accountable leadership, and teamwork. He believes infrastructure development must not only meet current needs but also be forward-looking to support the future growth and sustainability in the municipal area.

Born in Oudtshoorn, Witbooi started his primary education in Kimberley and completed his schooling in Oudtshoorn, matriculating from Bridgton Secondary School. He earned a Certificate in Civil Engineering and Building Construction from South Cape College, before furthering his studies at the Cape Peninsula University of Technology, obtaining a National Diploma and BTech in Civil Engineering.

Witbooi has over seven (7) years of experience with Aurecon/ Zutari (Pty) Ltd, where he was involved in the planning, design, and monitoring of civil engineering and municipal infrastructure projects. Over the past four years, he further advanced his career as a Project Manager and Professional Engineering Technician across various sectors, including local government. His tenure at Oudtshoorn Municipality provided valuable insight into municipal systems and service delivery processes.

Throughout his career, he gained extensive experience in water and wastewater systems, roads and storm water infrastructure, municipal infrastructure upgrades, and private developments. Notably, he played a key role in projects such as the Upgrading of Informal Settlements Programme (UISP) and Interim Basic Services (IBS) / Emergency Shared Basic Services projects, which have greatly improved living conditions and access to essential services.

“Technical Services is central to ensuring safe drinking water, sanitation, roads, storm water infrastructure and waste management, all services that our communities rely upon daily,” said Witbooi.

“My role is to lead a united technical team, promote accountability, uphold service excellence, and ensure services are delivered efficiently and sustainably.”

Upon entering the Bergrivier Municipal Area, he was impressed by the cleanliness of the towns and the absence of potholes. He praised the strong operational management and proactive maintenance planning in place, highlighting the commitment of staff to quality service delivery.



# RESEALING OF ROADS UNDERWAY IN PIKETBERG

Bergvriër Municipality has allocated R2.5 million in the 2025/2026 financial year for the resealing of several municipal roads across the Bergvriër Municipal Area, as part of its ongoing road maintenance programme. The project aims to extend the lifespan of existing roads, improve driving conditions, and enhance safety for all road users.

The resealing of municipal roads kicked off in Piketberg on Tuesday, 10 February 2026.

## The following streets were included in the project:

- Asblom Street: from Ranonkel to Pansy
- Ranonkel Street: from Kelkiewyn to Suikerkant
- Suikerkant Street: from Malva to Petunia
- Bokbaai Street: from Watsonia to Kosmos
- Loop Street: from the speed bump (AME) to Zebra
- Zebra Street: from Lang to Voortrekker
- Sand Street: from Voortrekker to Lang
- Waterkant Street: from Voortrekker to Buitengracht
- Sarel Cilliers Street: from Kloof to Calendula

## BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY EDUCATES THE YOUTH ON GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Gender-Based Violence (GBV) and human trafficking remain serious challenges in South Africa. These issues affect the safety, wellbeing, and future of many young people and families.

In partnership with the Gene Louw Traffic College, Bergrivier Municipality hosted an educational session on GBV and human trafficking for local youth and scholars at the Allan Boesak Community Hall in Piketberg on Monday, 8 December 2025.

These issues often affect communities quietly because they frequently go unnoticed and are, in many cases, unreported. This makes awareness and education essential. It is especially important for children and teenagers who are often more vulnerable. Through this awareness session, Bergrivier Municipality aims to empower young people with the knowledge and confidence they need to protect themselves and others. The session explained how to recognise early warning signs, understand risky situations, and identify trusted sources for professional help. Teenagers and children were encouraged to stay alert, trust their instincts, and reach out to a responsible adult or authority figure whenever they feel unsafe.

As the festive season approaches, law enforcement officials are urging children, teenagers, and parents to be extra cautious. Increased movement, busy public spaces, and holiday activities can create opportunities for exploitation and unsafe situations. By staying vigilant, looking out for one another, and reporting suspicious behaviour, the community can help ensure a safer and more enjoyable festive season for all.

Through open dialogue, education, and shared responsibility, Bergrivier Municipality continues to promote a culture of safety, support, and protection for every resident.

## Consider the source

Check the original author, its mission and the date of publishing



## Read Beyond

Headlines or catchy phrases can be outrageous in an effort to get clicks. What's the whole story?



## Check the author

Do a quick search on the author. Are they credible? Are they real?



## Check the author

Try to find supporting evidence or facts that confirms what you've read.



## Check the date

Check the date of content posted. Also, reposting old stories doesn't mean they're relevant to current events.



## Check your biases

Consider if your own beliefs could affect your judgement.


