

In doing so, this programme needs to touch on safety, a spatially enabling environment, social development, green and open spaces, an inclusive local economy and how all these aspects can be integrated," said Deputy Executive Mayor Alderman Mario Wessels.

## OPTIESE-VESELINSTALLASIE-MAATSKAPPYE DRUK BESIG OM HOËSPOED INTERNET NA BERGRIVIER TE BRING

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit verstaan dat al sy inwoners graag toegang tot hoëspoed-internet wil hê, wat verskeie aspekte van ons daaglikse lewe sal verbeter. Die Covid-19 pandemie se beperkende veiligheidsregulasies het die publiek gedwing om gebruik te maak van ander fasilitete eerder as hul normale werks- of opvoedingsplekke, wat sonder vinnige en betroubare internet ons daaglikse lewens verder negatief kan beïnvloed.

Ongelukkig bring sulke ontwikkelings tydelike negatiewe aspekte mee, soos onsmaklike voorkoms van die dorp, belemmerde toegang tot eiendom en onderbreking van dienste.

Munisipaliteite is onder geweldige druk van nasionale/provinsiale regering, besighede en die publiek om die verskaffing van optiese vesel te bespoedig, as 'n toevoeging tot die standaard noodsaklike dienste wat aan ons inwoners gebied word.

Die Munisipaliteit se bestuurs- en toesigfunksies tydens die installering van optiesevesel, deur die diensverskaffers, word fyn gebalanseer tussen die poging om die installasie vinnig te laat vorder en om te verseker dat wetgewing en interne beleide nagekom word.

Die Munisipaliteit en die optieseveselinstallasiemaatskappye het 'n ooreenkoms aangegaan om mekaar se belang te beskerm en om die publiek te voordeel uit vinnige en doeltreffende internet.

Die ooreenkoms sluit voorwaardes en spesifikasies in wat aan toepaslike wetgewing en beleide voldoen. Die ooreenkoms sluit ook uitleg-planne in wat posisies van vesel, oorhoofse en ondergrondse roetes deur privaat en openbare eiendomme verskaf. Munisipale personeel van die Direktoraat Tegniese Dienste is geïdentifiseer om toesig te hou oor nakoming ingevolge die ooreenkoms.

Bankwaarborgs is ten gunste van die Munisipaliteit verskaf vir 'n maksimum duur van 12 maande na voltooiing van die projek ingeval latente defekte opduik. Die optiese-veselinstallasiemaatskappye moet ook betaal vir enige verliese wat die Munisipaliteit tydens die projek ly, soos pypbreuke en waterverliese wat bo en behalwe die bankwaarborg is.

# BERGMUN'S R12,42 MILLION ROADS, STORMWATER AND SIDEWALKS PROJECT NEARING COMPLETION

Bergrivier Municipality's largest capital project for the 2021-2022 financial year valued at R12,42 million, for the upgrading of roads, stormwater and sidewalks in low cost housing areas within the various towns across the region, is nearing completion.

The project covers the towns of Aurora, Eendekuil, Piketberg, Porterville, Redelinghuis and Velddrif.

In terms of the Constitution, the provision of housing is a function of National and Provincial Government, and funding received from these spheres of Government was not sufficient to provide for paved sidewalks and the upgrading of roads in most housing projects in the past. Funding has now been made available to Bergrivier Municipality, through the Municipal Infrastructure Grant Programme (MIG), to upgrade sidewalks and roads in low cost housing areas.

According to Rohann Stander, Manager: Project Management Unit at Bergrivier Municipality, approximately 844 households (amounting to about 4220 people) will benefit from these upgrades. *"The upgraded road surface including sidewalks will improve pedestrian traffic, especially for people with disabilities or limited mobility, who need to venture to places of worship, schools and commercial areas along public transport routes," said Stander.*

The work currently being done in the various towns are as follows:

Aurora: R1 million (Approx. 340m of paved sidewalks);  
Eendekuil: R2 million (Approx. 740m of paved sidewalks);  
Piketberg: R3 million (Approx. 1 301m of paved sidewalks);  
Porterville: R1.5 million (Approx. 559m of paved sidewalks);  
Porterville: R927 127 (Roads and Stormwater in Smit Street, Porterville South);

Redelinghuis: R1 million (Approx. 340m of paved sidewalks); and  
Velddrif: R3 million (Approx. 1 145m of paved sidewalks).

Part of the MIG conditions are that unskilled labour be sourced from local communities. This project, therefore, created 34 temporary work opportunities for local people.

The practical completion of this project is scheduled for 30 June 2022. Further phases of this project are planned for the coming years.



# PIETIE FREDERICKS JEUGSENTRUM IN PIKETBERG AMPER VOLTOOI

Die langverwagte Pietie Fredericks Jeugsentrum se bouwerk vorder goed. Daar word verwag dat die jeugsentrum 'n sentrum van uitmuntendheid sal wees vir die jeug en holistiese jeugontwikkeling sal faciliteer. Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het ICA (Initiative for Community Advancement) aangestel om die sentrum te bestuur. Die jeugsentrum word in 2 fase voltooi met die opleidingsaal, kantoorspasie en nasorgfasiliteit wat in fase 1 voltooi word. Fase 2 sluit in 'n rekenaarsentrum en verdere opleidingsfasiliteite. Slegs plaaslike kontrakteurs is gebruik in die projek en dit is duidelik dat daar potensiaal in ons gemeenskap is in die konstruksie bedryf.

Op die regterkantste foto is die mure reeds geverf en die kontrakteurs is tans besig met afrondingswerk. # REVENUE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME IN BERGRIVIER

## "Residents urged to assist the Municipality"

Bergrivier Municipality is currently busy conducting its Revenue Enhancement Programme across the municipal area, to collect information from residents property with regards to water and electricity readings and the verification thereof, as well as personal information.

Bergrivier Municipality, in partnership with Ducharme Consulting, has embarked on this Revenue Enhancement process since November 2021. Regular targeted communication related to this programme will be issued on all official Municipal platforms for the duration of this project.

There are currently 11 field workers that form part of this programme. All fieldworkers are clearly identifiable as they are obliged to wear official name tags when on duty. There are flyers being distributed within the various towns which displays each fieldworkers photo and full names. They, however, do not work normal office hours and may approach your property in the late afternoon.

All personal information captured by the fieldworkers related to account holders are protected, kept confidential, and only used for Municipal purposes. This information is not provided to any third party.

In addition to the personal information that is updated, all measuring instruments are also checked, and various tests must be done on some of the instruments, as well as determining the necessary coordinates where the measuring instruments are installed. Access to these metered instruments are determined in terms of the Municipal By-laws and you are kindly requested to give the necessary access to the persons to obtain the information.

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit is tans besig om sy Inkomsteverbeteringsprogram regoor die munisipale gebied uit te voer, om inligting van inwoners se eiendom in te samel met betrekking tot water- en elektrisiteitlesings en die verifikasie daarvan, asook persoonlike inligting.

Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, in vennootskap met Ducharme Consulting, het hierdie Inkomsteverbeteringsproses begin sedert November 2021. Gereelde geteikende kommunikasie met betrekking tot hierdie program sal vir die duur van hierdie projek op alle amptelike Munisipale platforms uitgereik word.

Daar is tans 11 veldwerkers wat deel vorm van hierdie program. Alle veldwerkers is duidelik identifiseerbaar aangesien hulle verplig is om amptelike naamplaatjies te dra wanneer hulle aan diens is. Daar word pamflette in die verskillende dorpe versprei wat elke veldwerker se foto en volle name vertoon. Hulle werk egter nie normale kantoorure nie en kan u eiendom in die laatmiddag besoek.

Alle persoonlike inligting wat deur die veldwerkers vasgelê word, wat verband hou met rekeninghouers word beskerm, vertroulik gehou en slegs vir munisipale doeleinades gebruik. Hierdie inligting word nie aan enige derde party verskaf nie.

Buiten die persoonlike inligting wat opdateer word, word alle meterinstrumente ook nagegaan, en moet verskeie toetse op van die instrumente gedoen word, asook die bepaling van die nodige koördinate waar die meterinstrumente geïnstalleer is. Toegang tot hierdie meterinstrumente word in terme van die Munisipale Verordeninge bepaal en word u vriendelik versoek om die nodige toegang aan die persone te gee, ten einde die inligting te bekom.

# PAASNAWEEK PADBLOKKADES 'N REUSE SUKSES

"Ek is trots om aan te kondig dat daar geen sterftes was op ons paaie gedurende Paasnaweek nie." Só het Cavin Cornelissen, Hoof: Verkeersdienste by Bergrivier Munisipaliteit, gesê. Dankie aan alle motoriste, voeg hy by, wat versigtig op ons paaie gery het en wat gereeld die verkeersreëls nakom.

Die afgelope Paasnaweek (April 2022) het verskillende rolspelers soos die SAPD, Verkeers- en Wetstoepassingsdienste, CapeNature, Mediesenoeddienste, Redelinghuis Buurtwag en Brandweerdienste deel gevorm van verskeie padblokkades in die Bergrivier Municipale Gebied.


Die doel van die padblokkades is om te verseker dat motoriste se bestuurslisensie en voertuiglisensie skyfies geldig is. Dit is ook om seker te maak dat voertuie padwaardig is, en dat motoriste die padreëls gehoorsaam. Ander rolspelers kyk ook vir enige dwelms of diere wat onwettig vervoer word.

Die Uitvoerende Onderburgemeester, Raadsheer Mario Wessels sê hy is baie trots oor hoe die verskillende rolspelers saamgewerk het om 'n sukses van hierdie padblokkades te maak. "Ons padblokkades, veral gedurende 'n Paasnaweek, is suksesvol omdat alle relevante rolspelers betrokke is en 'n fantastiese diens kon lewer," het Wessels gesê.

Honderde voertuie is gedurende Paasnaweek afgetrek en daar is meer as 40 boetes uitgereik vir verskeie oortredings. Cornelissen het ook gesê dat 'n span uitgestuur is om oopruimtes, strande, oorde en hawegebiede te patroolleer.

"Ons doen 'n beroep op alle motoriste om binne die spoedgrense op ons paaie te bly en om nie onder die invloed van alkohol te bestuur nie," het Cornelissen afgesluit.





In onlangse nuus het ons opgemerk dat meer sake met betrekking tot onetiese gedrag veral in Plaaslike Regering voorkom in Suid-Afrika. Wat meer verbasend is, is die feit dat die mees onetiese gedrag plaasvind in organisasies wat beweer dat hulle hoë morele en etiese waardes handhaaf en die meeste van hierdie organisasies het baie goeie etiese kodes. Munisipaliteite in Suid-Afrika het gedragkodes vir beide raadslede en amptenare, maar ongelukkig lyk dit of onetiese gedrag erger word en dit kan die vertroue van die publiek belemmer.

Een van die kernwaardes van Berggrivier Munisipaliteit is, "Ons glo in etiese gedrag". Kernswaardes inisieer waardeskeppende pogings aangesien werknemers geïnspireer voel om te doen wat reg is, selfs wanneer die regte ding moeilik is om te doen. Etiese gedrag word vanuit die topstruktuur van 'n organisasie gedryf. In Berggrivier Munisipaliteit glo ons in waardegedrewe leierskap en om die regte toon van etiese gedrag van bo af aan te gee, regdeur die hele organisasie.

### **Wat is etiese gedrag?**

'n Persoon wat etiese gedrag toon, het bewyse van 'n sterk morele kode en 'n konsekwente stel waardes. Etiel kan geleei word in geloof of die strewe om die wêreld beter te maak. Diegene wat etiese gedrag uitbeeld, doen die regte ding, ongeag of hulle krediet daarvoor kry of daarvoor gediskrediteer kan word. Hierdie soort gedrag is nie net beperk tot die werkplek nie, maar kan in elke aspek van die lewe toegepas word. In 'n munisipale omgewing is etiese gedrag van toepassing op enige werknemer, toesighouer, bestuurder, direkteur of raadslid. Hulle moet gedrag toon wat eerlik en regverdig is in hul verhoudings met hul kollegas en die gemeenskap. Om goeie etiese gedrag te toon het 'n uitwerking op munisipale moraal en kliënteverhoudings. Dit is makliker vir 'n munisipaliteit om werknemers te behou wanneer hulle vir 'n munisipaliteit werk waarin hulle glo en waar etiese gedrag sterk is.

Goeie nuus kom van organisasies met etiese werkplekkulture waar vertroue in topbestuur hoog loop wat goeie bestuur, goeie dienslewering en finansiële volhoubaarheid tot gevolg het. Om dit eenvoudig te stel: Hoë etiel skep hoë vertroue, hoë vertroue skep hoë prestasie. Berggrivier Munisipaliteit streef werklik na die bereiking van hoë prestasie en gevolglik word dit ook gedemonstreer deur ses (6) agtereenvolgende skoon oudits van die Ouditeur-generaal te verkry.

Gedurende Junie 2022 sal die munisipaliteit fokus op etielbewusmaking deur die belangrikheid van etiese gedrag te demonstreer en te beklemtoon en verder 'n etiese werkplekkultuur te skep. Etiel sluit werk, speel, gesin, onderwys, gemeenskap, politiek en aanbidding in. Deur etiese gedrag te bevorder gee ons uitvoering aan ons visie: "'n Vooruitstrewende gemeenskap waar almal wil leef, werk, leer en speel op 'n menswaardige manier".

# UIT DIE PEN VAN DIE BURGEMEESTER

Een van die belangrikste gebeurtenisse in Suid-Afrika is wanneer die Sensus gedoen word, wat vereis dat alle burgers in die land getel moet word. Die Wes-Kaap en meer spesifiek die Weskus Distrik (insluitend Bergvryheid Munisipaliteit) is net oor die die 80% merk (Sensus 2022) wat 'n groot impak het op die aantal befondsing wat provinsies en munisipaliteite sal kan ontvang vanaf Nasionale Regering vir verskeie dienste. U kan wag om deur 'n StatsSA -veldwerker besoek te word of u kan [getcounted.statssa.org.za](http://getcounted.statssa.org.za) besoek om die vraelys self te voltooi. Dit is kardinaal belangrik dat almal getel word.

Die veiligheid van ons gemeenskappe is baie belangrik. Die misdaadsyfers wat styg in ons gebied steek ons almal soos 'n mes deur die hart. Kom ons leef nader aan mekaar, sien om na mekaar en meer belangrik, kom ons wees lief vir mekaar. Alleen sal ons nie misdaad kan bekamp nie. Laat ons die sosiale euwels in ons gemeenskappe hokslaan en 'n veilige omgewing skep vir almal.

Ons het 'n groot onwettige storting uitdaging in ons dorpe wat veroorsaak dat die Munisipaliteit baie geld moet uitgee om hierdie kwessie aan te spreek. Onwettige storting is nie net sleg vir toerisme en vir die beeld van 'n dorp nie, maar dit het ook negatiewe gesondheids-implikasies vir huishoudings wat naby aan hierdie *hotspots* bly of kinders wat op hierdie plekke speel. Plaas asseblief u rommel uit op die dae wat die Munisipaliteit u rommel afhaal en gooi asseblief u rommel in 'n vullisdrom. Onthou om u herwinbare materiaal in die deurskynende sak te plaas vir herwinningsdoeleindes.

Dit is kommerwekkend dat voorvalle van vandalisme en kabeldiefstal teen 'n onrusbaarlike tempo toeneem in die Bergvryheid Munisipale Gebied. Dit is nie net 'n duur proses om toerusting en kabels wat gevandaliseer en gesteel word, te vervang nie, maar dit veroorsaak 'n gebrek aan basiese dienste. Ons moedig inwoners aan om eienaarskap te neem van alle munisipale fasiliteite en om insidente van vandalisme en kabeldiefstal onmiddellik te rapporteer. Kom ons staan saam om hierdie kriminele aktiwiteite hok te slaan. Enige persoon wat 'n incident van vandalisme en kabeldiefstal aan die Munisipaliteit rapporteer mag dalk beloon word as die inligting of bewyse direk tot skuldbevinding aan die misdaad lei.

She was born in Wellington and recently qualified as a Certified Internal Auditor, which is the only globally recognised internal audit certification. This certification allows practitioners to optimally communicate knowledge, skills and competencies, to effectively carry out professional responsibilities within an internal audit space.

Ranna was appointed as from 01 March 2022 to serve in the position of Internal Auditor on a full-time basis. She studied Accounting at Stellenbosch University and obtained her degree in 2011. Ranna previously worked at Swartland Municipality for six years (6) in the Internal Audit Unit.

The Internal Audit Unit is responsible for evaluating the adequacy and effectiveness of controls in responding to risks with regards to achievements of the municipality's strategic objectives; reliability and integrity of financial and operational information; effectiveness and efficiency of operations and programs; safeguarding of assets and compliance with laws, regulations, policies, procedures and contracts.


