55% WATERBEPERKINGS

Sedert 25 Januarie 2018 is die hele Bergvlei Municipale gebied op 45% waterbeperkings. Dit beteken dat elke persoon slegs **50 liter water per persoon per dag** mag gebruik. Dit gebeur nog nie. Op ons huidige verbruik word **dag zero** bereken vanaf **15 Mei 2018**, maar ons kan dit uitstel deur soveel as moontlik te bespaar. Kom ons mik vir 55%. Ons vra graag dat ALMAL minder as 50 liter water per dag sal gebruik. Dag zero is in ons hande!

Is dit veilig om ons kraanwater te drink? Ja, dit is! Indien 'n kook-instruksie of geen-drink-water-instruksie in die toekoms aangekondig word, sal u dit deur amptelike kanale hoor.

Baie dankie vir almal se heelhartige samewerking! Ons het tydens Januarie 2018 43% water bespaar en tydens Februarie 2018 49%. **Nou moet ons NOG meer spaar en by 55% uitkom om dag zero so lank as moontlik af te weer.**

We are in the middle of the worst drought in 114 years in the Western Cape. It affects us all! Thank you to all for saving water!



Nasionale noodtoestand aangekondig op 13 Maart 2018

Die Nasionale Minister van COGTA verantwoordelik vir Plaaslike Regering, het op 13 Maart 2018 'n nasionale noodtoestand aangekondig vir die hele Suid-Afrika as gevolg van die droogte. Die Wes-Kaap, Oos-Kaap en Noord-Kaap bly die ergste geteisterde gebiede.

'n Tekort aan water is nie 'n "Kaapstad" probleem nie! Ons almal deel dieselfde waterbronne! Dit is 'n "ONS" probleem! Die Weskus word veral erg geraak met 'n groot water tekort.



Dag zero...

Die situasie in die Weskus is veral erg en dag zero word tans bereken vanaf 15 Mei 2018 op huidige verbruik. The West Coast is particularly hard hit and day zero is predicted from 15 May 2018 on current usage.

But day zero is a moving target and we can avert it by saving more!

Dag zero is in ons hande...

Water Quality in Bergvrijer Municipality:



The water quality is analysed on a weekly basis by an independent service provider according to 4 criteria, namely microbiological, chemical, physical organoleptic and SANS 241. The results are captured on the National Database of the Department of Water Affairs and Sanitation. Based on the calculated average of these four criteria, Bergvrijer Municipality achieved 98,8%. This achievement is above the norm and represents excellent water quality.

The Municipality will never provide potable water (purified for use in a household) if it is not safe for human consumption. If the weekly results show a decline in water quality, the public will be informed and if necessary an instruction to boil the water before drinking it will be issued. At present the household water in Bergvrijer Municipality is 100% safe for drinking from the tap. No bottled water is needed. Save your money for day zero.

Bergvrijer Municipality does everything in our power to ensure day zero does not happen. But every resident must use less than 50 liters per person per day. This is still not enough!

Wat verwag ons van almal in Piketberg?

Elke persoon moet minder as **50 liter per dag** gebruik. Ons is nog nie daar nie.

Velddrif/Noordhoek en Dwarskersbos: die waterverspreidingsnetwerk kom via Withoogte Waterskema en Saldanhabaai Municipality. Hier is die berekende dag zero ook 15 Mei 2018, want hulle water kom ook uit die Misverstanddam. Almal moet minder as 50 liter per dag gebruik. Dit sal help om dag zero so lank as moontlik uit te stel.

Bergvrijer Municipality is currently searching for alternative water sources in Piketberg and has already drilled three boreholes. The borehole behind Piketberg Primary School pumps 18 000 liters per hour, but the water quality test results are not yet available. The second borehole behind Kloofstraat does not pump any water. The third borehole, which was drilled on the mountain side, is still being tested. (Information as of 15 March 2018)
