TENDERS are hereby requested from competent and experienced contractors for the Civil Construction Works for the Upgrading of the existing Piketberg Wastewater Treatment Works and Associated Works: Phase IV, as set out in the specifications. It is estimated that bidders should have a **CIDB grading of 4CE** or higher and should provide valid proof thereof.

Bids, in sealed envelopes, clearly marked <u>"Tender No 8/3/46-2021 / MN215/2021: Civil Construction</u> <u>Works for the Upgrading of the existing Piketberg Wastewater Treatment Works and Associated</u> <u>Works: Phase IV"</u>, must be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices, 13 Kerk Street, Piketberg no later than <u>12:00 on Friday, 12 November 2021</u> when the bids will be opened in public.

Tender documents can be obtained from Revedy Hendricks, Bergrivier Municipality, 13 Kerk Street in Piketberg, during normal office hours from Monday to Friday 08h00 – 16h00, at a cost of <u>R500.00 per set</u> (Vat Inclusive). The amount must be deposited into the account of Bergrivier Municipality at <u>Nedbank, Piketberg, Current Account No.: 116 976 1380, Branch 198765.</u> The reference number when doing payment is T 8/3/46-2021 – Company Name. Proof of payment is necessary when collecting tender documents. <u>Documents will be available from Monday, 25 October 2021 at 09h00.</u> All technical enquiries can be addressed to Mr. Wikus Burger at tel. no. Tenders must be valid and binding for one hundred and twenty (120) days after closing date.

A compulsory clarification meeting to be held on Tuesday, 02 November 2021 at 11h00, in the Council Chambers of Bergrivier Municipality, 13 Kerk Street, Piketberg, whereafter bidders will move to the actual worksite.

This invitation supports the national government's local manufacturing initiatives. Only locally produced goods, with a set minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered. The Bid documentation submitted MUST be subject to local content as set out in the specifications (Steel products and components – 100%; Cement – 100%; Plastic Pipes – 100%; Cables – 90%; Textile and leather – 100%; Valves – 70%; Pumps – 70%).

Bids will be evaluated using the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy. It is therefore compulsory that the Preference Point Claim form for the Preferential Procurement Regulations is completed in full to make application for preference points. <u>The Bid price must be VAT inclusive.</u>

Bidders must be registered as a prospective supplier on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD). The Tax Clearance Certificate/ Tax Compliance Status (TCS) Pin/ Centralised Suppliers Database (CSD) Registration Number must be submitted together with the bid. Failure to submit a Tax Clearance Certificate/TCS Pin/CSD registration number may result in the invalidation of the bid.

Only bids completed in **black** ink on the original Bid documentation will be accepted. Late, incomplete or Bids submitted by facsimile or email will not be accepted. Proof of submitting a Bid will not be accepted as proof of the Bid having been received. The Municipality is not obliged to accept the lowest or any Bid submitted to it. The Municipality reserves the right to accept any Bid in full or in part. If prices offered are cost effective Council reserves the right to procure more items to take financial advantage thereof.
