Council meets the public: Bergrivier Municipality's Council approved the third review of the IDP (2022-2027) as well as the 2025-2026 budget at a Council Meeting held on Tuesday, 27 May 2025 at the Eendekuil Community Hall in Eendekuil. This was the third year in a row that the Municipality held its Council Meeting in the public domain. Speaker Alderman Rhandal Swarts chaired the Council Meeting. The Municipality would like to thank all members of the public for attending. Democracy in action!

BUDGET APPROVED BY COUNCIL FOR 2025-2026

"Sustainability and good governance were the main driving forces in attracting investor confidence in the Bergrivier Municipal Area".

These were the words of Alderman Ray van Rooy, Executive Mayor of Bergrivier Municipality, during a Council Meeting held in the Eendekuil Community Hall on Tuesday, 27 May 2025. This was the third time Bergrivier Municipality took its Council Meeting to the public in a community hall. The meeting was also live-streamed on YouTube.

Bergrivier Municipality's budget for the 2025-2026 financial year, totalling at just over R759 million, was approved by Council.

Van Rooy mentioned that sound management decision-making, nine (9) consecutive clean audits and a stable political landscape has been instrumental in ensuring effective governance, enhancing public trust, and enabling the Municipality to deliver on its strategic objectives.

Despite presenting a bright outlook ahead, Van Rooy, cautioned residents by mentioning that the Municipality's growing expenditure bill is proving to be a significant stumbling block for service delivery efforts.

"It's very difficult to address all the needs within our communities with the limited available resources that we have. It is for this reason that we've decided to invest in infrastructure, since it forms the backbone of service delivery and ensures that our communities function efficiently in the long-term," said Van Rooy.

The budget was drafted and aligned to the needs of the communities we serve, as documented in the approved Integrated Development Plan (2022-2027). *See page 3 for more details regarding the approved budget.*

ONS GLO IN INNOVERENDE VENNOOTSKAPPE



STAPTOER: 'n Afvaardiging van Heist-op-den-Berg Gemeente in België het onlangs Bergrivier Munisipaliteit besoek as deel van die twee munisipaliteite se bestaande "twinning"- program. Tydens hul besoek is die delegasie op 'n staptoer in die pragtige Piket-Bo-Berg, waar hulle die asemrowende natuurskoon, plaaslike biodiversiteit en unieke berglandskap van die streek eerstehands kon ervaar. Hierdie besoek het nie net die bande tussen die twee munisipaliteite versterk nie, maar ook kulturele uitruiling en wedersydse waardering bevorder. Hierbo is die span van Bergrivier en Heist-op-den-Berg!

The approved budget consists of the following:

- Capital Budget of R96,547 million; and
- Operational Budget of R663,115 million.

Van Rooy indicated that in order to fund this budget, increasing tariff charges were unavoidable, but it was done responsibly after much deliberation.

Tariff increases which will take effect as from 1 July 2025:

Water increases by 5.5%;
 Electricity increases by 13.95% (subject to NERSA's approval);
 Refuse removal increases by 5.5%;
 Sewerage increases by 5.5%; and
 Property Rates increases by 5.5%.

"The largest portion of our capital budget for the 2025-2026 financial year will go towards improving our infrastructure responsible for water and electricity. It's fundamental that we invest in our infrastructure for future development, investor confidence and service delivery, especially in the Velddrif, Noordhoek, Eendekuil and Redelinghuys areas," said Van Rooy.

During his budget speech, Van Rooy highlighted that, as from 1 July 2025, all residents receiving indigent subsidies will receive a 100% rebate on their property taxes until June 2026.

Additionally, Van Rooy mentioned that Council recently wrote off millions in debt owed to the Municipality, and implemented stronger credit control measures to recover outstanding funds, however, these measures have impacted some residents negatively. "It's important that residents who are able to pay their municipal accounts, to do so. We need every cent to deliver effective services in our communities, and we cannot do that without all account holders paying on time," he said.

The Municipality will, however, continue to support the vulnerable within the communities through the implementation of indigent subsidies to qualifying households, which will receive a support package consisting of 50 free electricity units, 6 kilolitres of free water and a 100% subsidised standard household refuse removal and sewerage tariff per month.

Van Rooy concluded his speech by thanking the Budget Steering Committee under the leadership of Councillor Daniels, the Municipal Manager, the Chief Financial Officer and the staff in the Strategic Services Department and Budget Office, Directors and other personnel who were involved in compiling the budget and related documents.

144 HUISE OORHANDIG AAN BEGUNSTIGDES IN BERGRIVIER



'249 HUISE MOET NOG OORHANDIG WORD' - SÊ BEHUISINGSEENHEID

Die Wes-Kaapse Regering (Departement van Infrastruktuur) in vennootskap met Bergrivier Munisipaliteit het op 28 Maart 2025 met trots die eerste 45 huise (20 begunstigdes in Piketberg en 25 begunstigdes in Porterville) aan begunstigdes van die Piketberg- en Porterville- behuisingsprojekte oorhandig. Hierdie oorhandiging is 'n belangrike mylpaal in die munisipaliteit se verbintenis tot die voorsiening van kwaliteit behuising en die verbetering van inwoners se lewens.

Tydens die oorhandigingseremonie het Uitvoerende Burgemeester, Raadsheer Ray van Rooy, aan alle begunstigdes verduidelik dat die huis aan hulle behoort en dat hulle eienaarskap daarvan moet neem. "Dit is julle dag - wees trots. Dit is die begin van 'n nuwe hoofstuk vir u en u gesin. Geniet julle huis," het Van Rooy, gesê.

Die Wes-Kaapse Minister van Infrastruktuur, Tertius Simmers, het saam met Uitvoerende Burgemeester Ray van Rooy die sleutels persoonlik aan die nuwe huiseienaars oorhandig en die lint geknip vir van die oudste begunstigdes - 'n simboliese begin van 'n nuwe hoofstuk vir hierdie gesinne.



Minister Simmers het genoem dat hy baie trots is om hierdie oomblik saam met die begunstigdes te deel, wie lank gewag het om hul nuwe huis te ontvang. "Dankie dat u almal geduldig was en altyd geglo het dat hierdie dag sal kom. Hierdie is u dag - u is nou die eienaar van 'n splinter nuwe huis. Neem verantwoordelikheid vir u huis en kyk mooi daarna," het Simmers gesê.

Mev Trytjie Sampson (89), is die oudste begunstigde in Piketberg wat die sleutels tot haar nuwe huis ontvang het. Sampson het gesê sy is sprakeloos en het nie woorde om haar opgewondenheid te beskryf nie. "Ek is baie dankbaar en dank God dat Hy vir my hierdie huis gegee het. Ek gaan die hele dag skoonmaak en werk in my nuwe huis," het Sampson gesê.

Intussen is sowat 144 huise reeds oorhandig en 249 huise moet nog in die komende maande aan begunstigdes in Porterville, Piketberg en Eendekuil oorhandig word.

Baie dankie aan alle belanghebbendes, veral die Wes-Kaapse Departement van Infrastruktuur, vir hul bydrae om hierdie projek 'n werklikheid te maak.





PORTEVILLE ROCKED BY HEAVY RAINFALL AND FLOODING IN APRIL

Porterville experienced stormy weather and heavy rainfall on 8 April 2025, resulting in widespread flooding across the town - with the main road being particularly affected.

An estimated 130mm of rainfall was recorded within a single day (8 April 2025).

While no injuries were reported, damage to several private and public infrastructure were reported. Temporary road closures were also in place, which led to traffic interruptions, however, within a few hours all roads were declared safe to travel on.

The clean-up operations began soon after the heavy rainfall had subsided, and lasted for about 3 days.

Approximately 107 households were significantly affected by the flooding, causing damage to their properties and household goods. The Disaster Management personnel were on-site assisting affected residents throughout the town, to help salvage their belongings and to provide sandbags to block the constant stream of water entering their properties.

The Municipality extends its sincere gratitude to the community of Porterville for their patience, assistance and cooperation during the clean-up period, to restore normality in the town.

A special thanks to all stakeholders who contributed warm food, blankets, clothing and other items to provide relief to all the affected families.

WINTERSEISOEN: VOORKOMING VAN STORMWATERPROBLEME

Tydens die winterperiode ontvang die Munisipaliteit gewoonlik navrae van die publiek rakende stormwaterblokkasies, wat skade aan eiendomme veroorsaak:

Hier is hoe dit opgelos kan word:

- Indien u eiendom laer geleë is as dié van u buur, is dit waarskynlik dat stormwater tydens swaar reën vanaf die hoër geleë buur-eiendom na u eiendom sal vloeи, solank die vloeи van die stormwater natuurlik bly;
- Indien die eienaar van 'n eiendom stroom-op van u ('n buur) die natuurlike vloeи van stormwater versteur, moet die saak spoedig tussen die eienaars aangespreek word;
- Stormwater kan op verskeie maniere veilig van hoër na laer geleë eiendomme gekanaliseer word, soos byvoorbeeld deur ondergrondse stormwaterpype of oop stormwaterkanale aan te bring (hierdie kanale moet gereeld skoongemaak

word om blokkasies te voorkom);

- Indien daar 'n grensmuur tussen u en u buur opgerig is, maak seker dat die grensmuur nie die natuurlike vloeи van water van die hoër na die laer geleë eiendom verhinder nie. Dit kan gedoen word deur 'n dreineringstelsel aan te bring of deur eenvoudig 'n paar openings in die grensmuur te maak om die natuurlike vloeи van water te verseker.

Ons moedig alle inwoners aan om reënwater vanaf hul dakke na waterstoortenks en / of na die straat te lei deur middel van geute en pype, om watervloeи-probleme te voorkom. Die belangrikste is om moontlike oplossings vir watervloeи-kwessies met u buur te bespreek.

Open communication with your neighbour is key to resolving any stormwater concerns.

Borehole Water in Velddrif:

The Municipality has been informed by the West Coast District Health Office that traces of arsenic have been found in private borehole water in the Velddrif Area. It is recommended that all households that have access to borehole water and want to make use of it for human consumption should have the water tested. BERGRIVIER MUNICIPALITY HOSTS 4TH EDITION OF THE ANNUAL MAYORAL EASTER RUGBY CUP


